WATER: The hydrant flushing is done and they will reflush after Beaver Falls has started their new process. There was a malfunction in the telemetry system for the water tower on June 3, 2010 due to a lightning strike. The Secretary will turn the damage into the insurance company. The system is being worked manually until we receive the parts for repair.

ROADS: The Township received two quotes for the tar and chipping of Bridge Drive. The Supervisors will have Attorney Lope draw up an agreement for the property owners for a one time improvement along Bridge Drive on private property. Doug Rice to dig a ditch along the west side of Bridge Drive. Alan Dambach motioned to accept A R Oliastro's quote to do the double coat tar and chip for \$3626.70, Dean Davis seconded. TGAYE ADAYE DDAYE Attorney Lope will send a notice to Trumco Logging and their bonding company putting them on notice that we will call in the bond if restoration is not done on Ben Venue Road. Supervisor Dambach is working to have the bridge over the railroad on West Road replaced by the railroad.
