

The regular meeting of the Marion Township Supervisors was called to order July 12, 2010, at 4:00 p.m., at the municipal building. Supervisors Thomas George and Alan Dambach were present. Supervisor Dean Davis was absent. Also attending were Marilyn Zona, Philip Lope, Rudolph Harkins, Elnora Freshcorn, William Hummel, Doug Rice, Dave Kopp, David Hoover, and Joanne Weil.

The minutes of the June 14, 2010 were approved and adopted on a motion by Alan Dambach, seconded by Tom George. TGAYE ADAYE

Bob Phillips from Thought Process Enterprises demonstrated the completed web site for the Township to the Supervisors.

WATER: Hydrant flushing after Beaver Falls implements the new process for chlorination in August will be done. The hydrants have not yet been painted.

SEWAGE: Alan Dambach motioned to approve and sign the Monthly Sewage Report, Tom George seconded. TGAYE ADAYE

ROADS: The bid opening for West Road work: A R Oliastro- \$28,752.57, I A Construction- \$22,177.75, Youngblood Paving- \$21, 812.00. Alan Dambach motioned to accept the bid from Youngblood Paving subject to Mr. Hummel's review, Tom George seconded. TGAYE ADAYE Mr. Rice will clean the ditches and dig out and fill the soft spots on West Road before the paving begins. The berms will need done immediately after the paving is done so the semi's from TSO don't damage the road edges. Mr. Rice reported that the damage to Ben Venue Road has been repaired. Alan Dambach motioned to release the bond for Ben Venue Road to Trumco, Tom George seconded. TGAYE ADAYE Mowing of the roads will start July 14, 2010. The Supervisors, James Hull from the PUC, the Railroad and other interested parties met at the bridge over the railroad on West Road to discuss replacement. The Supervisors, Commissioner Charles Camp, and Representative Jason Altmire will meet at a day yet to be determined to discuss funding of the replacement of the bridge over the railroad on West Road.

ENGINEER: Mr. Hummel reported that Penn Dot will have new regulations that will make the Township responsible for policing the upkeep of drains created from HOPs.

POLICE: The Police report was submitted and approved as follows: Total hours worked: 276.5 hours, Total mileage: 391 miles, Arrests-1, Citations issued: 14, Warnings issued: 19, Total Calls for June: 14, Mutual Aid calls: 4. Chief Harkins reported that Penn Dot has approved doing a speed limit study of Hartzell School and Route 588 and for the "No passing farm equipment" signs for the intersection of Hartzell School and Pine Run Roads.

PLANNING COMMISSION: Mrs. Freshcorn reported that the Commission is still working on Zoning updates and that Roy Raida attended a seminar on Airport Zoning.

ZONING: Permits issued in the month of June to Zwigart-Schmude for a storage building, and Roger Hardy-deck.

SOLICITOR: Mr. Lope presented the employment agreement for Officer Paul Smith. Alan Dambach motioned to sign the Employment Agreement with Officer Paul Smith, Tom George seconded. TGAYE ADAYE

Alan Dambach motioned to adopt and sign Resolution 2010-03 Opposition to forced Local Government mergers, Tom George seconded. TGAYE ADAYE
