

The regular monthly meeting of the Marion Township Supervisors was called to order at 4:00 p.m., February 14, 2011, at the municipal building. Supervisors Thomas George, Alan Dambach, and Dean Davis were present. Also present were Philip Lope, Rudolph Harkins, Marilyn Zona, William Hummel, Doug Rice, Elnora Freshcorn, Mary Kopp, Dave Kopp, and David Hoover.

The minutes of the January 3 and 10, 2011 meetings were approved and adopted on a motion by Dean Davis, seconded by Alan Dambach. TGAYEADAYEDDAYE

WATER: Bill Robbins pressure pump is not working right and Doug Rice asked the Supervisors who will be responsible for repair or replacement. Dean Davis motioned to repair or replace the pumps already in place (Robbins, McCartney, Stumpf) for lifetime of current owner, if property changes hands it will be new owners responsibility and the Supervisors will address any future pressure pumps in a amendment to the Water Ordinance, Alan Dambach seconded. SEWAGE: Dean Davis motioned to approve and sign the Monthly Sewage Report, Alan Dambach seconded. TGAYE ADAYE DDAYE

ROADS: The repair of Hartzell School Road could start as early as February 15, 2011. Oliastro is unable to get anymore cinders for snow removal so he has delivered a load of limestone chips.

POLICE: The Police Report for January, 2011 was submitted and approved as follows: Total Hours Worked: 352 hours, Total Mileage: 1910 miles, Citations Issued: 3, Warnings issued: 5, Total calls: 16, Mutual Aid calls: 3 The Officers completed update training for 2011 January 31 and February 1, 2011. A new AED and a battery for the old one was purchased. We now have two units, one for the building and one for the car.

PLANNING COMMISSION: The Commission is asking the Board if there is anything they want reviewed in the Zoning Ordinance. Mr. George asked that Zoning Districts be reviewed and Attorney Lope said the Commission should include oil and gas development and he will send some model ordinances.

ZONING: Building permit issued in the month of January to Al Langer for a new house and garage. The Supervisors discussed the doublewide that is still on Dave Kopp's Property. It was to be removed when he finished his new home. Mr. Kopp told the Supervisors that he is looking for property to move it to. The Supervisors will revisit the situation monthly. The Baust's would like to build a garage on their property which is in the flood plain. They will be contacted and told to bring plans to the Planning Commission meeting.

SOLICITOR: Attorney Lope advised the Board that there will be a meeting at the West Road Bridge on March 7, 2011 at 1:30 p.m. He also asked for an Executive Session to discuss real estate and police matters.

Alan Dambach motioned to adopt Resolution 2011-1 appointing Kenn Hermann as Voting Delegate for Marion Township on the Beaver County Tax Collection Committee, Dean Davis seconded. ADAYE TGAYE DDAYE

Dean Davis motioned to advertise the seven year review of the Agricultural Security Area and to send letters to all members for inclusion or exclusion, Alan Dambach seconded. TGAYE ADAYE DDAYE

The Supervisors reviewed the Big Knob Fire Department 2010 Report.

Dean Davis motioned to accept the resignation of Derek Zona as auditor effective immediately, Alan Dambach seconded.
