

The regular monthly meeting of the Marion Township Supervisors was called to order at 4:00 p.m., on Monday, March 14, 2011, at the municipal building. Supervisors Thomas George and Alan Dambach were present with Dean Davis arriving 5 minutes late. Also present were Rudolph Harkins, Philip Lope, Marilyn Zona, William Hummel, Elnora Freshcorn, Doug Rice, Dave Kopp, Don Goehring, and Rich Christy.

The minutes of the February 14, 2011 meeting were approved and adopted on a motion by Alan Dambach, seconded by Thomas George. ADAYE TGAYE

WATER: Doug Rice has requested that the Township purchase a magnetic locator for locating curb stops and water lines. Alan Dambach motioned to purchase a magnetic locator for no more than fifteen hundred dollars, Dean Davis seconded. TGAYE ADAYE DDAYE The Zelenople Municipal Airport is requesting peak flow and residual pressure at an anticipated tap location for the Airport to purchase water from the Township. The Supervisors will contact Malcolm Pirnie for help in compiling the information and reply to the Airport that we are taking the request under consideration.

SEWAGE: Dean Davis motioned to approve and sign the monthly Sewage Report, Alan Dambach seconded. TGAYE ADAYE DDAYE The Supervisors reviewed the letter and report from Malcolm Pirnie concerning new chemicals being used at Veka. The new Treatment is actually more environmentally friendly.

ROADS: Work is being done on the drains on Hart Road and when completed the berms will be repaired. The Supervisors will hold road inspection April 5, 2011 at 9:00 a.m. beginning at the municipal building. Doug Rice reported that there is water running off the hill at the lower end of Ben Venue Road and Veka has called to complain about problems with berms on Veka Drive. Bob Rice from Veka Drive would like the Township to clean the drainage ditch on his property. The West Road Bridge meeting is set for March 28, 2011 at 1:30 p.m.

POLICE: The Police Report for the month of February, 2011 was submitted and approved as follows: Total hours worked: 314 hours, Total mileage: 1130 miles, Arrests: 1, Citations issued: 6, Warnings issued: 12, Total calls for February: 14, Mutual Aid Calls: 5. Chief Harkins asked the Supervisors to consider hiring a part-time Patrolman for 1 to 2 shifts per week for 32 to 64 hours per month. The Chief will gather the cost figures to present to the Supervisors.

PLANNING COMMISSION: The Commission is working on Zoning revisions.

ZONING: Marilyn Zona asked if the Supervisors would consider an Ordinance requiring landlords to be responsible for letting the Township know who is renting. The Solicitor will research the request. The Zoning Officer will try and meet with the manager of Camp Kon-O-Kwee about recent building activity and permanent residents and Pam Nelson concerning cabins being turned into permanent residences.

SOLICITOR: The signed agreement for the Fombell Post Office is in the hands of C J Betters.

Mr. Dambach reported that he met with Ken Hermann concerning the EIT Committee. The Secretary will send a letter asking how we will keep Central Tax collecting the way they are now and contact North Sewickley and Franklin Townships to see if they have an alternate member for the EIT Committee.

Mr. Rice is working on four items for Hazard Mitigation to be submitted to the County by March 17<sup>th</sup>.

Alan Dambach motioned to sign the Filing of Uncollected Real Estate paperwork, Dean Davis seconded. TGAYE ADAYE DDAYE

Alan Dambach motioned to sign and file the Municipal Pensions and Fire Relief paperwork, Dean Davis seconded. TGAYE ADAYE DDAYE

Alan Dambach motioned to appoint Ralph Young and Robert Guidice to the Agricultural Security Committee, Dean Davis seconded. TGAYE ADAYE DDAYE

Rich Christy told the Supervisors that there will be a benefit for the Joe Weil Memorial beginning at 10 a.m., April 30, 2011 with a hayride and then a party at the Blinn Pond. All money will go to the Pine Valley Bible Camp.

Alan Dambach motioned to pay the bills, Dean Davis seconded. Roll Call: Mr. George-yes, Mr. Dambach-yes, Mr. Davis-yes
