

The regular monthly meeting was called to order at 4:00 p.m., Monday, April 11, 2011, at the municipal building. Supervisors Thomas George, Alan Dambach, and Dean Davis were present. Also present were Philip Lope, Rudy Harkins, Marilyn Zona, William Hummel, Doug Rice, Elnora Freshcorn, Frank Sidari, David Hoover, and Dave Kopp.

The minutes of the March 14, 2011 were approved and adopted on a motion by Dean Davis, seconded by Alan Dambach. TGAYE ADAYE DDAYE

WATER: The magnetic locator approved for purchase at the last meeting was bought for \$969.23. Mr. George reported that Jeff Miller from Veka told him that the meter head was only off for two days. The Township thinks it is more like five days. Mr. George will talk with him again and advise that we will divide 517000 gallons, which was the water we know they used, by the days that the meter was on for the month. We will then multiply that number by the number of days that the meter was off. The Supervisors discussed the Gray large water use and will advise them that they can pay over 3 months. The Township will send a notice to all water users for them to take a meter reading. The Supervisors will have Doug Rice dig up the water line at the Beers residence and place a new curb stop and turn off his water. Frank Sidari from Malcolm Pirnie attended concerning the Zelenople Airport request for water. It may not be legal for the Township to sell outside of our municipality. Frank will contact Gannett Fleming, the Airport's engineer, for further information about who they have contacted about service.

SEWAGE: Alan Dambach motioned to approve and sign the Monthly Sewage Report, Dean Davis seconded. TGAYE ADAYE DDAYE

ROADS: The Spring Road Tour report was not available. Mr. Hummel estimated that to concrete the gutter on Ben Venue Road would be \$6,000 for the material. Mr. Dambach will meet with Mr. Rice at Hart Road to discuss the drainage issues. The ditch at Veka Drive is on Bob Rice's property and the Township is not responsible for it. Veka sent a letter to the Township letting us know that they support all of the work the Township is doing to have the railroad bridge replaced at West Road. Mr. George is to talk to Rich Godsen to see if he is serious about taking over ownership and responsibility of the bridge.

POLICE: The Police Report for the month of March, 2011 was submitted and approved as follows: Total hours worked: 357.5 hours, Total mileage: 1852 miles, Arrests: 1, Citations issued: 19, Warnings issued: 16, Total mutual aid calls: 5.

PLANNING COMMISSION: Mrs. Freshcorn reported that the Commission is working on a new Zoning Map.

ZONING: Attorney Lope has a Rental Ordinance for the Supervisors to review. Mrs. Zona reported that a number of properties in the Township are collecting and storing junk and junk cars. Mr. Lope will review our Zoning and Junk Yard Ordinances for the proper sections to cite violators and Mrs. Zona and Chief Harkins will visit all properties in the Township and compose a list of violators.

SOLICITOR: Mr. Lope presented the amendment to Water Ordinance 87-2 concerning costs and responsibilities of pressure pumps. Alan Dambach motioned to advertise the proposed amendment to Ordinance 87-2 for adoption at the May 9, 2011 meeting, Dean Davis seconded. TGAYE ADAYE DDAYE
The Township needs to contact the County Treasurers Office whether Small Games of Chance are allowed in the Township.

The Secretary will contact North Sewickley and Franklin about their EIT Committee alternate.

The Supervisors set May 7th, 2011 from 9 to 4 for the annual Trash Day.
