WATER: There has been no response from the airport concerning their request for water since the letter sent for us by Malcolm Pirnie, May 23, 2011. Attorney Lope advised the Board that he contacted the PUC and was told that we can sell water to the airport. The Rozzo and Agnew trailer meters need to be changed.

Ken Herrmann our representative on the Board for Act 32 EIT collection attended the meeting to bring the Supervisors up to date on his Boards decisions. There will be a universal Tax Payer Bill Of Rights and Wage Tax Ordinance that will have to be adopted by all Beaver County municipalities.

SEWAGE: Dean Davis motioned to approve and sign the monthly Sewage Report, Alan Dambach seconded. TGAYE ADAYE DDAYE

ROADS: The roads will be mowed the week of July 4th. Mecklem Road berms and swale worked on, Veka bend and entrance patched. The upper part of Hart Road was completed. The Supervisors would like to meet with Oliastro about the berming work he did on Mecklem Road last year, it is not holding up. Mr. Hummel will contact Penn Dot to find out what we can post legally on Herman Road because of the geometry of the road. Dean Davis motioned to have Chief Harkins start the process of a study on Herman Road if Mr. Hummel finds that we can post due to geometry.
