

The regular monthly meeting was called to order at 4:00 p.m., Monday, October 10, 2011, at the municipal building. Supervisors Thomas George and Dean Davis were present. Alan Dambach was absent. Also present were Marilyn Zona, Philip Lope, Rudolph Harkins, William Hummel, Doug Rice, Elnora Freshcorn, Patricia Niedfeldt, David Hoover, PJ Moldovan and Dave and Mary Kopp.

The minutes of the September 12, 2011 meeting were approved and adopted on a motion by Dean Davis, seconded by Tom George. TGAYE DDAYE

ROADS: PJ Moldovan, Chief Harkins, and Alan Dambach inspected the emergency access road from Veka across the West Road Bridge. The base of the road is good. They are concerned about winter access. The gate needs to be bigger, there are trees in the way and the road needs to be widened. Mr. Rice met with Jim Miller from Veka and Veka needs a letter on the work that needs done. Attorney Lope will confer with Jim Druschel of Veka and the Attorney for CSX to see if Veka and the Railroad will contribute to the access road and have the railroad replace the planking on the bridge and fix rails. The Township is considering placing a fire hydrant somewhere close to or on West Road and will send a letter to TSO to see if they would contribute to the hydrant. Dean Davis motioned to order the signs that are needed from the inventory that Chief Harkins has finished, Tom George seconded. DDAYE TGAYE The Township will consider a slurry coat on the bend and north end of Herman Road next year and will ask Penn Dot to place Route 588 directional signs. Mr. Hummel advised the Supervisors that North Sewickley is going to patch Glendale Road and send the bill to the Township for our portion.

WATER: THE Secretary was instructed to call Alan Bennett and advise him that he must call the Township when he needs the water on at 1421 Route 588.

SEWAGE: Dean Davis motioned to approve the monthly Sewage Report, Tom George seconded. DDAYE TGAYE Tom George motioned to authorize Paul Kremer to sign and send the Monthly Sewage Reports, Dean Davis seconded. TGAYE DDAYE

POLICE: The Police Report for September, 2011 was submitted and approved as follows: Total hours worked: 363.5 hours, Total Mileage: 2215 miles, Citations issued: 21, Warnings issued: 19, Total calls: 19, Mutual Aid: 2. Tom George motioned to purchase the police equipment from the COG grant contingent upon confirmation that the funds are available, Dean Davis seconded. TGAYE DDAYE

The Supervisors agreed to place an ad in the Butler Eagle for the leasing of the Post Office property.

Tom George motioned to adopt Resolution 2011-3, for establishing a Regional Board of Appeals through the COG for the Uniform Construction Code, Dean Davis seconded. TGAYE DDAYE

The Supervisors agreed to give Dave Kopp until June 1, 2012 to move the double wide from his property. The secretary will send a letter to Mr. Kopp stating the agreement.

The secretary and Police Chief will send a letter to the YMCA Camp concerning permits for fireworks and communication concerns.
