

The regular monthly meeting was called to order on Monday, January 9, 2012, at 4:00 p.m., at the municipal building. Supervisors Thomas George, Alan Dambach, and Dean Davis were present. WATER: Mr. George reported that the Caldwell readout is not working.

SEWAGE: No report.

ROADS: There will be a meeting on the West Road railroad bridge in Pittsburgh, Tuesday, January 10, 2012 at 10:00 a.m. before the Administrative Law Judge. Mr. George and Attorney Lope will attend. The 15 mph speed limit sign has been purchased for Herman Road.

POLICE: The Police Report for the month of December, 2011 was submitted and approved as follows: Total hours worked: 353.5 hours, Total Mileage: 1995 miles, Warnings issued: 1, Arrests: 1, Total calls: 14, Mutual aid calls: 2. The new Police car is still not ready. The grant for the new equipment has a 30 to 45 day turn around for the money to be received. The Department conducted a drug search at the Riverside High School.

PLANNING COMMISSION: The Commission reviewed a request from Maria Stumpf to have a business at her home to sell small storage buildings and chicken coops. There recommendation is that the request should be denied. The Secretary will send a letter to Ms. Stumpf.

ZONING: No report.

SOLICITOR: Mr. Lope explained that he investigated the Goehring's loss of farm equipment from the Police car accident. Their insurance paid \$8000 and the Township insurance paid the deductible of \$500. The Goehrings spent \$13500 to replace the lost equipment. The Township insurance will not pay anything more on the loss. Jim Goehring stated part of the \$13500 is freight to get the new equipment to his farm. Mr. Lope advised that they should turn that expense into their insurance company. The Letter that Attorney Lope composed to the YMCA concerning voluntary PILOT will be sent on Township letterhead.
