

The regular monthly meeting was called to order at 4:00 p.m., Monday, March 12, 2012 at the municipal building. Supervisors Thomas George, Alan Dambach, and Dean Davis were present. Also present were Philip Lope, Rudolph Harkins, Marilyn Zona, William Hummel, Doug Rice, Elnora Freshcorn, David Hoover, Dave Kopp, and Ken Hickman.

The minutes of the February 13, 2012 meeting were approved and adopted on a motion by Dean Davis, seconded by Alan Dambach. TGAYE ADAYE DDAYE

WATER: Mr. Rice reported that the North Sewickley meter pit cover was stolen and recovered by the Township police.

SEWAGE: No report.

ROADS: Attorney Lope presented an agreement for the West Road Bridge with the Railroad. The agreement is for a right-a-way along railroad tracks to the bridge for an emergency access route, a waterline and fire hydrant. The Railroad will agree to pay \$20000. Dean Davis motioned to authorize Attorney Lope to sign the settlement agreement on behalf of the Township and to have Bill Hummel survey the ground for the right-a-way, Alan Dambach seconded. TGAYE ADAYE DDAYE The Supervisors set April 10, 2012 at 9:00 a.m. for road inspection. Mr. Rice told the Board that potholes were patched on Herman and Petrie Roads.

POLICE: The Police Report for February 2012 was submitted and approved as follows: Total Hours worked: 305 hours, Mileage: 1707 miles, Arrests: 1, Total calls: 17, Mutual Aid: 3. Officer Paul Smith was injured while assisting North Sewickley Township and is off on worker's compensation. The Township needs to have a written process for future claims in place and also a Township Worker's Comp doctor. The Chief and Secretary will compose the process and send a letter to Apple Occupational Health Services asking if they will be the Township Worker's Comp doctor. The new police vehicle is ready for pickup Tuesday March 13, 2012. Dean Davis motioned to issue a check for \$31438 for the police vehicle, \$10393.50 to be paid from the insurance money from the wrecked vehicle, Alan Dambach seconded. SOLICITOR: Attorney Lope reviewed the new LST Collection Agreement with Central Tax Bureau, Dean Davis motioned to approve and sign the agreement, Alan Dambach seconded. TGAYE ADAYE DDAYE

Ken Hickman presented a framed map of the original subdivision of Marion Township. He also spoke to the Supervisors about the Big Knob Fire Department. They are just not for fires, they are also search and rescue and accident traffic control.
