WATER: Dean Davis motioned to adopt Resolution 2013-1 Connection Fees for the Marion Township Water Line, Tom George seconded. TGAYE DDAYE

SEWAGE: Dean Davis motioned to have Tom Hartwig of Arcadis begin the process to renew the Industrial Sewer User Agreement with Veka, the present agreement will expire 8/11/13, Tom George seconded. TGAYE DDAYE

ROADS: Bill Hummel reported that Heilman Paving has checked the pavement on Petrie Road that Doug Rice felt may ravel in the future due to large stone in the mix. Heilman said they will repair the places in question. Mr. Rice will meet with Jenny LTD concerning plowing snow on the emergency route for West Road. The secretary will check with Penn Dot about the guide rails that were to be placed on Hartzell School Road at the Fombell bridge.

POLICE: The Police Report for December, 2012 was submitted and approved as follows: Total hours worked: 336 hours, Total mileage: 2,249 miles, Traffic stops: 21, Total calls: 16, Mutual Aid calls: 7. Chief Harkins reported that Police Dog Recon has been placed with a private family.

PLANNING COMMISSION: Mr. Rice reported that the Commission will have the Gas Ordinance ready for the Supervisors review at their February meeting.

ZONING: A building permit was issued in December to Joseph Danylo for a garage. No report on a building condemnation Ordinance.

SOLICITOR: Attorney Casker reported that Attorney Lope is working on the Berkheimer Agreement and will review the latest Centax paperwork. They are waiting for the Planning Commission to work on the Gas Well Ordinance.

The Secretary will contact the YMCA Director concerning the meeting about PILOT.

Five members of the Big Knob Fire Department attended the meeting concerning their contract with the Township that expired December 31, 2012. They discussed the recent changes with home owners insurance that has seen higher premiums for those more than five miles from a fire station. They would like to consider putting a truck somewhere in our Township but would need a heated 20' x 40' building. They were considering asking for a \$2000 to \$5000 raise in the yearly payment from Marion Township for fire coverage. Dean Davis motioned to extend the current contract with Big Knob Fire Department for one year with a \$2000 increase for a total of \$12,000 for the year 2013, Alan Dambach seconded. TGAYE ADAYE DDAYE The Fire Department will present a new 5 year contract to the Supervisors within the next few months.
