Attorney Lope also gave the Supervisors two building condemnation ordinances for review. The Agreement with Berkheimer should be ready for signing at the next meeting.

The Supervisors are still waiting for a meeting with the YMCA about PILOT.

Mr. Dambach reported that he met with Honeywell and plotted out land that they are going to consider donating to the Township.
