

The regular monthly meeting of June 10, 2013 was called to order at 4:00 p.m. at the municipal building. Supervisors Thomas George, Alan Dambach, Dean Davis were present. Also present were Philip Lope, Rudolph Harkins, Marilyn Zona, Doug Rice, Elnora Freshcorn, David Hoover, and Bob Coyner.

WATER: The McQuiston unpaid repair bill in the amount of \$384.50 was discussed. Attorney Lope advised that we send a letter to both Darlene McQuiston, the resident, and Dale Agnew, property owner, stating that we will lien the property if the bill remains unpaid. Mr. Rice questioned whether the hydrant was still to be installed at West Road and Route 588. The project was included in the 2013 Budget and the Supervisors told Mr. Rice to install the hydrant. Mr. Rice told the Board that North Sewickley will have the meter in the North Sewickley pit tested at Marion Township's expense the week of the 17th of June.

SEWAGE: No report.

ROADS: The Supervisors will have Engineer Hummel solicit 3 quotes for the milling and sealing of Hart Road. The Supervisors will ask Mr. Hummel to include the widening of the bend on Veka Drive in the bids for paving. Alan Dambach motioned to advertise for bids for the paving of Veka Drive and the lower end of Householder Road, Dean Davis seconded. ZONING: A building permit was issued in the month of May to Travis Weisz of Route 588 for a garage.

SOLICITOR: Attorney Lope reviewed the Building Condemnation Ordinance with the Supervisors. Alan Dambach motioned to advertise the Building Condemnation Ordinance for adoption, Dean Davis seconded. TGAYE ADAYE DDAYE

The Public Safety building was discussed. The Township is looking for grant funds to build the building. No word yet from Honeywell on the acquisition of land for the building.

The Supervisors discussed a weed spraying program with Bob Coyner instead of mowing the sides of the Township roads. Alan Dambach motioned to have Coyner Enterprises spray our roadsides for time and material at the same rate as last year and revisit the program early spring 2014 to possibly spray twice in 2014, Dean Davis seconded. The Township will check with some Township residents to see if anyone is interested in cutting down the dead ash tree on our property.
