WATER: The fire hydrant at West Road and Route 588 has been installed, still needs painted.

SEWAGE: Colleen Martin, SEO, contacted the Township concerning Scott Convery's need to move forward with a system design for a new on lot sewage system. She needs to know whether the Township would like another enforcement letter sent or should she pursue enforcement action with the Sewage Solicitor. Mr. Convery tried to subdivide his property in 2010 and had to have his present system tested. The system failed and the Sewage Association has been trying to work with Mr. Convery to install a new system. The Supervisors will contact Mr. Convery and try to set up a meeting to discuss a plan of action with him.

ROADS: The Secretary reported that the cost for sealing the north end of Herman Road was \$1600.00.

POLICE: The Police Report for the month of November was submitted and approved as follows: Total hours worked: 339 hours, Total mileage: 2207 miles, Traffic stops: 17, Total calls: 21, Mutual aid calls: 8. Steve Campbell from Abartha Energy contacted the Township about a gas lease for the Mount Pleasant Cemetery property. The Township maintains the property and will tell him that he can proceed with the paper work for a gas lease for the property, but they might have to petition the court for ownership. The Supervisors will also tell Mr. Campbell about our property on Eckert Stop Lane.
