

The regular meeting of Monday, January 13, 2014 was called to order at 4:00 p.m., at the municipal building. Supervisors Thomas George, Alan Dambach, and Dean Davis were present. The minutes of the December 9, 2013 meeting were approved and adopted on a motion by Dean Davis, seconded by Alan Dambach.

**WATER:** The Faller residence and Honeywell Sewage plant need there meters changed. Mr. Rice reported that North Sewickley is replacing a culvert that could interfere with our water supply so that Zelianople is on standby to supply water to the Township. Zelianople has replumbed our meter pit with two meters, one to supply them and one to supply the Township when needed.

**SEWAGE:** The meeting with Scott Convery has not yet been scheduled.

**ROADS:** The Supervisors discussed whether land owners are responsible for the cost of clearing trees that fall across Township roads. The Secretary will ask at the next COG secretary/manager meeting whether other municipalities charge the land owner.

**POLICE:** The Police Report for December was submitted and approved as follows: Total hours worked: 232 hours, Mileage: 1412 miles, Traffic stops: 9, Total calls: 13, Mutual Aid: 8. The Chief reported that scrap theft is on the rise in the Township and surrounding communities. The Secretary will check with our insurance carrier concerning heart and lung coverage for a heart attack that does not happen on duty.
