WATER: The Faller water meter is still not changed. The hydrants need to be flushed. Alan Dambach motioned to contract with Liquid Engineering to have the water tank inspected and if need be cleaned. The lone bid for snow removal was opened. Jenny LTD bid \$78.00/ hour for snow removal in the Township. Alan Dambach motioned to accept Jenny LTD's bid for snow removal, Dean Davis seconded.
