

The regular meeting for the month of May of the Marion Township Supervisors was called to order on Monday, May 9, 2016, at 4 p.m., at the municipal building. Supervisors Thomas George, Alan Dambach and Dean Davis were present. Also present were Philip Lope, Frank Evanson, Marilyn Zona, Elnora Freshcorn, Linda George, Keith Pisarik, Matt Bearrow, Dave Kopp and Jeremy Rice.

The minutes of the April 11, 2016 meeting were approved and adopted on a motion by Dean Davis seconded by Alan Dambach. TGAYE ADAYE DDAYE

WATER: The meter in the North Sewickley meter pit has been replaced.

SEWAGE: Attorney Lope advised the Board that he has been meeting and working with Scott Convery to obtain the money to install the new septic system.

ROADS: The road paving program was discussed: Mr. Hummel sent the Board an estimate to pave Bridge drive with Heilman, one inch depth \$10,880, one and a half inch depth \$13,919. Matt Bearrow from Cardinal Midstream told that Board that if the bid for Householder came in around the estimated price of \$13,530 that Cardinal would pay for it. He also said they would pay to pave the portion of Mecklem Road from the driveway of the pigpen to Ridge Road. From the estimates given by Engineer Hummel at the April 11, 2016 meeting Alan Dambach motioned to advertise for bids to superpave the portions of Householder, Mecklem and Herman Road that was estimated, to bid superpave for Bridge Drive, the portion of Mecklem from the pigpen driveway to Ridge Road, and the municipal parking lot, Dean Davis seconded. POLICE: The Police report for the month of April was submitted and approved as follows: Total hours worked: 272 hours, Total calls: 14, Traffic stops: 0. The department had the RMS computer program installed in April and a monitor for the security system for the building. Alan Dambach motioned to send the Mutual Aid Agreement that was drafted by Solicitor Lope to the municipalities that border Marion Township, Dean Davis seconded. PLANNING COMMISSION: No report.

ZONING: Penn Energy submitted a request to the Zoning Hearing Board for an extension of time for the previously granted variance on the limiting heights for potential obstructions. The Zoning Officer is inspecting Township properties for Zoning violations.

SOLICITOR: Attorney Lope discussed the Findings of Fact, Conclusions of Law and Decision on the Blinn Conditional Use Hearing. Alan Dambach motioned to approve and sign and send the Findings of Fact, Conclusions of Law and Decision on the Blinn Conditional Use, Dean Davis seconded. TGAYE ADAYE DDAYE

The Supervisors discussed the issue of trash day held on the Rice property in Franklin Township and decided to keep it at the property this year and revisit it next year.

The Supervisors will get options and estimates on renovation of the Township Office.

There has been no movement on the Veka Fire agreement.

Alan Dambach motioned a \$100 memorial donation in honor of Doug Rice's mom who recently passed away, Dean Davis seconded.

Alan Dambach motioned to approve and sign the Municipal Guidelines Checklist from RA Services, Dean Davis seconded. TGAYE ADAYE DDAYE
