

The regular meeting for the month of June of the Marion Township Supervisors was called to order on Tuesday, June 14, 2016, at 4 p.m., at the municipal building. Supervisors Thomas George, Alan Dambach and Dean Davis were present. Also present were Chris Reese, Frank Evanson, William Hummel, Marilyn Zona, Elnora Freshcorn, Jeremy Rice and Dave Kopp.

The minutes of the May 9, 2016 were approved and adopted on a motion by Dean Davis, seconded by Alan Dambach. TGAYE ADAYE DDAYE

WATER: Dean Davis motioned to approve the expenditure of \$1,482 for equipment to be placed in the North Sewickley meter pit that will enable the Township to check the daily usage of water from the Mission web site, Alan Dambach seconded. TGAYE ADAYE DDAYE

SEWAGE: Attorney Reese advised the Board that Attorney Lope is still trying to resolve the Convery sewage issue.

ROADS: The bids for the summer paving program were opened on Friday June 10, 2016 with Youngblood as the low bidder at 92,914.00, Shields Asphalt at \$98,606.73 and Protech Asphalt at \$115,167.99. The Supervisors reviewed all the alternates of the bid. Alan Dambach motioned to accept and sign the Youngblood Paving bid and to do all projects in the bid, to use \$30,000 from the Act 13 money and \$20,000 from the State Fund and the rest from General Fund, Dean Davis seconded. POLICE: The Police Report for the month of May was submitted and approved as follows: Total hours worked: 331 hours, Total calls: 27, Traffic stops: 3. The Mutual Aid Agreements with surrounding municipalities have not been sent out yet. The Supervisors asked Attorney Reese for that to be done.

PLANNING COMMISSION: No report.

ZONING: No building permits issued in the month of May. Mark Reese, the Township building inspector from MDIA has retired. John Balsler will now be our inspector.

SOLICITOR: The Supervisors asked that a letter be sent to the Blinn's giving them a date at which they must be in compliance with their Conditional Use Permit or face civil enforcement and fines.

The Township will seek quotes on renovation of the Township Office.

Dean Davis motioned to donate \$100 to the Salvation Army in memory of Lois Hummel, Alan Dambach seconded. TGAYE DDAYE ADAYE

Dean Davis motioned to invest \$54,000 of the Post Office Account monies, Alan Dambach seconded. TGAYE ADAYE DDAYE

The Township will send letters to Representative Marshall, Senator Vogel, and Penn Dot concerning the condition of the east end of Route 588.

Alan Dambach motioned to pay the bills, Dean Davis seconded. Roll Call: Mr. Davis-yes, Mr. George-yes, Mr. Dambach-yes.

The Supervisors went into executive session at 5:15 p.m. and returned at 5:30 p.m.

Alan Dambach motioned to hire Robert O'Neill, Timothy Waibel, and Eric McPhilomy as part time Patrolman at a rate of \$17.00/hour, Dean Davis seconded. TGAYE ADAYE DDAYE
