

The regular meeting for the month of July of the Marion Township Supervisors was called to order on Monday, July 11, 2016, at 4:00 p.m., at the municipal building. Supervisors Thomas George and Alan Dambach were present. Also present were Philip Lope, Frank Evanson, William Hummel, Marilyn Zona, Jeremy Rice, Casey Bowers and Elnora Freshcorn.

The minutes of the June 14, 2016 meeting were approved and adopted on a motion by Alan Dambach, seconded by Thomas George. ADAYE TGAYE

WATER: A water shut off notice has been sent to 300 Hartzell School Road and the Secretary told the Board that 1177 Route 588 has not paid their bill since November and was supposed to pay a week ago and never did. The Board was in agreement to send a shut off notice to 1177 Route 588.

SEWAGE: Mr. Lope is in discussion with Penn Energy to have gas lease money released so that Scott Convery can install his new system.

ROADS: Penn Dot has given Marion Township their project number for road paving, so the notice to proceed will be sent to Youngblood Paving. Jeremy Rice reported that the work on Steinbach Road (patch holes and scraping berms) and the work on Veka Drive (patch holes on bend and new sign) has been completed

POLICE: The Police Report for the month of June was submitted and approved as follows: Total hours worked: 297.5 hours, Total Calls: 38. Chief Evanson reported that all 3 part-timers have been sworn in.

PLANNING COMMISSION: No report

ZONING: A building permit was issued to Veka for a silo in the month of June. The Zoning Officer told the Board that the property at 1174 Route 588 has stalled on the cleanup and that the property owner will receive another enforcement letter. The Board discussed issues with properties that have dwellings that are occupied but unfit for habitation.

SOLICITOR: The new Mutual Aid Agreements have been sent to all of the Township's adjoining municipalities. Zelenople's Chief has a few questions concerning the agreement and Chief Evanson will contact him. The Board asked that Chief Evanson contact the other Chiefs to make sure there are no problems with the agreement.

The Board and Secretary will make a list of ideas for the office renovation.
