

The regular meeting for the month of September of the Marion Township Supervisors was called to order on Monday, September 12, 2016 at 4:00 p.m. at the municipal building. Supervisors Alan Dambach, and Dean Davis were present, Supervisor Thomas George was absent. Also present were Chris Reese, Frank Evanson, William Hummel, Marilyn Zona, Elnora Freshcorn, Jeremy Rice, Lonnie Vodenicher, Casey Bowers, Gerald Goehring, and Dave Kopp.

The minutes of the August 8, 2016 meeting were approved and adopted on a motion by Alan Dambach, seconded by Dean Davis. ADAYE DDAYE

WATER: Lead and copper testing will be done this month. TTHM and SHAA testing has been completed. Jeremy Rice has remarked 588 for curb stops with the road paving that is ongoing.

SEWAGE: Penn Energy is working with the Convery attorney to release lease money to have the septic repair done.

ROADS: The potholes on Nagel Road still need filled. The drains along Herman Road need cleaned in preparation of paving. Alan Dambach motioned to advertise for bids to contract for snow removal, Dean Davis seconded. PLANNING COMMISSION: Mrs. Freshcorn reported that the Commission felt really bad denying the request of Rachel Mignogna to subdivide her land. The Commission is still working on updating the Zoning Ordinance.

ZONING: Building permits issued in the month of August: Josh Graeff-garage, Tim Stives-storage building.

SOLICITOR: Attorney Reese advised the Board on the Blinn Event Center/Conditional Use Permit. The Secretary will contact MDIA for an update on the Blinn submittals.

The Board reviewed two bids for office renovations. The office renovations were tabled.
