

The regular meeting for the month of December of the Marion Township Supervisors was called to order on Monday, December 12, 2016, at 4:00 p.m., at the municipal building. Supervisors Thomas George, Alan Dambach, and Dean Davis were present. Also present were Philip Lope, Frank Evanson, Marilyn Zona, William Hummel, Elnora Freshcorn, Lonnie Vodenichar, William Kennelly, Jim Marshall, Bob Crissinger, Casey Bowers, Doug Rice, Jeremy Rice, and Dave Kopp.

Alan Dambach motioned to approve and adopt the minutes of the November 14, 2016 meeting, Dean Davis seconded. TGAYE ADAYE DDAYE

WATER: Sharon Caldwell has asked that the Supervisors consider help for her water bill because the cistern that she uses for her horses has been contaminated and she has to use Township water for her horses. The Supervisors discussed the problem and she will advised that the Township cannot lower her water bill.

SEWAGE: No report.

ROADS: The work on the catch basin on Householder Road and the Ash tree on Ben Venue has not been completed. Veka has requested a stop sign to be placed on Veka Drive where their parking lots empty on to the road. Pedestrians/workers crossing the road from the parking lot have had trouble with vehicles not stopping for them. Attorney Lope will check if the Township must adopt an ordinance or resolution to place the stop sign.

POLICE: The Police Report for the month of November, 2016 was submitted and approved as follows: Total hours worked: 333 hours, Total Calls: 30, Traffic stops: 9. Chief Evanson reported on a problem on Dambach Lane between residents concerning care of the lane. Attorney Lope advised that it is a private lane and a civil matter. SOLICITOR: The agreement with the Convery's is near completion. The Blinn Appeal of the Uniform Construction Code has been turned over to the Beaver County COG Appeal Board. All of the Police Mutual Aid Agreements have been signed except for Franklin Township.

There has been no progress on the building renovation, Mr. George is to check with John Sockaci. Work progressing on the light for the flag.

Lonnie Vodenichar, the Big Knob Fire Department liaison with the Township, told the Board that he is retiring in January and a replacement has not been named.
