Tom George motioned to pay the bills, Dean Davis seconded. Roll Call: Mr. George-yes, Mr. Davis-yes

Dean Davis motioned to adjourn the meeting until Tuesday June 13, 2017 at 4:00 p.m. when Mr. George could be at the meeting in person, Tom George seconded. TGAYE DDAYE

The meeting for the month of June, 2017 was reconvened at 4:00 p.m. on Tuesday, June 13, 2017 at the municipal building. Supervisors Dean Davis and Thomas George were present with Supervisor Alan Dambach on the phone. Also present were Philip Lope, William Hummel, Marilyn Zona, Dave & Mary Kopp, Joe Schwab, Casey Bowers and Doug Rice were present.

The minutes of the May 8, 2017 meeting were approved and adopted on a motion by Dean Davis, seconded by Tom George. TGAYE DDAYE ADAYE

WATER: The water hydrants were flushed, still need greased and painted. The line on the bridge over the Connoquenessing was checked.

SEWAGE: The draft proposal from DEP of the Township's NPDES permit renewal for the Veka Plant has been received and forwarded to Tom Thompson for review and comment.

POLICE: The Police Report for the month of May was submitted and approved as follows: Total Hours worked: 371 hours, Total calls: 29, Traffic stops: 1, Mutual aid: 1. Alan Dambach motioned to have Team Signs restripe the Ford Expedition at a cost of \$480, Dean Davis seconded. TGAYE ADAYE DDAYE Solicitor Lope gave the Supervisors copies of new Policy and Procedures for the Police Department for the Supervisors to review.

PLANNING COMMISSION: The Board is continuing with review of the draft of the revised Zoning Ordinance. The Supervisors advised Doug Rice that if the position of Secretary of the Planning Commission has changed, the Commission needs to pass it by motion and have it in the minutes.

ZONING: Building permit issued in the month of May to R J Kraus for an addition to his home.

Attorney Lope advised the Board that the Convery septic system should be installed at the next meeting.

The plans that Barb Blinn resubmitted to the Secretary were not sent to MDIA. Mrs. Blinn is asking for an agricultural building permit. Solicitor Lope advised the Supervisors that the plans must go through MDIA and he will talk to Mrs. Blinn's engineer.

ROAD REPORT: Joe Schwab from Penn Energy presented plans to change the intersection of Ben Venue Road and Pine Run Road. The northern entrance will be widened to two lanes to accommodate truck traffic. Penn Energy will also improve Ben Venue Road to the driveway entrance of the well on Ben Venue Road. Dean Davis motioned to sign the paperwork to submit plans to Penn Dot to alter the intersection of Ben Venue and Pine Run, Tom George seconded. TGAYE ADAYE DDAYE Alan Dambach motioned to accept the proposal of \$6330 from Dirt Worx for summer road work, Dean Davis seconded. TGAYE ADAYE DDAYE Penn Energy is going to get a price from Lindy Paving to repave Nagel Road. The Township has a price from Oliastro for Double seal of \$9980, Heilman \$14200 and Youngblood \$ 13,746.
