

The regular meeting for the month of October of the Marion Township Supervisors was called to order on Monday October 9, 2017 at 4:00 p.m., at the municipal building. Supervisors Thomas George, Dean Davis and Alan Dambach were present. Also present were Chris Reese, Mike Pszenny, Marilyn Zona, William Hummel, Roy Raida, Jeremy Rice, Casey Bowers, Joe Schwab and Ron Reyer.

The minutes of the September 11, 2017 meeting were approved and adopted on a motion by Dean Davis, seconded by Tom George. TGAYE DDAYE ADAYE

WATER: Attorney Reese presented the signed Water Agreements with Zelenople Borough and North Sewickley Authority to raise the Daily Water Withdrawal Limits.

SEWAGE: Attorney Reese presented the amendment to the Sewage Agreement with Veka to raise the Boron Limit. Alan Dambach motioned to approve and sign the amendment to the Industrial Sewage Agreement and send to Veka for approval and signing, Dean Davis seconded. TGAYE ADAYE DDAYE

ROAD REPORT: The lone bid for snow removal was opened. Dean Davis motioned to accept and sign the contract with Jenny LTD for snow removal at a rate of \$82/ hour, Alan Dambach seconded. Penn Energy will bond the road. There will be a preconstruction meeting that Mr. Hummel and Alan Dambach will attend.

POLICE: The Police Report for the month of September was submitted and approved as follows: Total Hours worked: 287 hours, Total calls: 20, Citations: 4, Mutual aid: 1. The Chief and Assistant Chief completed their firearms qualifications for 2017. The Ford Expedition will be striped on October 11.

PLANNING COMMISSION: Roy Raida presented the Board with and updated Zoning Ordinance Draft. He advised the Board on plans that the Zelenople Airport has for expansion.

ZONING: No building permits were issued in the month of September.

Attorney Reese advised the Board that a certified letter was sent to the Blinns giving them until March 1, 2018 to obtain a building permit for their barn at their party venue. The letter was received by the Blinns. The Supervisors instructed Attorney Reese to set up a meeting with a representative from Veka, Big Knob Fire Department, Harmony Fire District, Beaver and Butler Control to take place at the Township building sometime the week of November 6.
