

The regular meeting for the month of May of the Marion Township Supervisors was called to order on Monday, May 9, 2022, at 4:00 p.m., at the municipal building. Supervisors Dean Davis, Thomas George and Alan Dambach were present. Also present were Chris Reese, Mike Pszenny, Marilyn Zona, Tom Thompson, Roy Raida, Mr. & Mrs. Griffen, and Amanda Peterson,

Dean Davis motioned to approve and adopt the minutes of the April 11, 2022 meeting, Alan Dambach seconded.  
TGAYE DDAYE ADAYE

WATER: J J Kennedy and YMCA meters have been installed. The Great Southern meter and North Sewickley valve still needs replaced. The main meter in the North Sewickley pit is not reading. A Sensus representative will be here Tuesday to check it. There may be problems replacing it. North Sewickley will estimate our bill until it is fixed.

SEWAGE: Veka has provided the monthly analytical information that is required but has not used the form that is needed. Solicitor Reese has requested they provide the information using the form.

ROADS: Tom Thompson presented the road inspection report. Householder and Glendale Roads – no comment, Bridge Drive – Clean drain at top, West Road – install sign “emergency traffic only” at gate, Veka Drive – add millings to bend at plant entrance, Eckert Stop Lane – send letter to Chris Spencer to clean vacant property, Herman Road – ditch at 251 needs cleaned and pipe repaired, clean ditches, patch surface where top coat peeled, fix potholes at 144, Nagel – clean out ditch at upper end, Hart – no action, to be tarred and chipped, Petrie – add millings to entrance at Chapel, fill in bend area, Mecklem - add millings on right going uphill from Brush Creek Road, Steinbach – add 4 inch drain, gravel sump to inlet on right side, asphalt roadway once drainage in installed, Mueller Hill – clean ditch, Ben Venue – fill potholes on right side of hill, clean ditch on right side uphill, clean ditch and inlet on paved portion, fix asphalt patch at 159. The supervisors will seek estimates on asphaltting Steinbach Road. Alan Dambach motioned to purchase a flashing chevron sign for Herman Road, Dean Davis seconded. TGAYE ADAYE DDAYE Supervisor Dambach discussed the meeting he and Chief Pszenny had with Zelig Lawn Care about the past winter snow removal. Zelig Lawn Care would like delineators on some of the roads. The Township definitely wants cinders used.

ENGINEER: No report.

POLICE: The Police Report for the month of April, 2022 was submitted and approved as follows: Total hours worked: 306.5 hours, Total Calls: 31, Mutual aid: 2, New Sewickley: 12 calls. After discussion, Alan Dambach motioned to purchase all Motorola radios thru the County grant, also replacing the radio in the new car with a Motorola, Dean Davis seconded. TGAYE ADAYE DDAYE

PLANNING COMMISSION: The planning commission discussed the Skillman day spa and solar energy at their meeting.

ZONING: Building permits issued in the month of April - none

SOLICITOR: Attorney Reese reported there has not been movement on House Bill 1037. The solicitor requested an executive session to discuss a potential litigation issue.

Alan Dambach motioned to approve the estimate of Roach and Zeigler of \$3600 to purchase carpet for the rental, Dean Davis seconded. TGAYE ADAYE DDAYE
