

The regular meeting of the Marion Township Board of Supervisors was called to order on Monday, April 13, 2015, at 4:00 p.m., at the municipal building. Supervisors Alan Dambach and Dean Davis were present, Thomas George was absent. Also present were Philip Lope, Rudolph Harkins, Marilyn Zona, Bill Hummel, Elnora Freshcorn, David Hoover, Don King, Lonnie Vodenichar, RJ Kraus, Casey Bowers, Joe Schwab, Pete Alouise, Dave Kopp, and Jeremy Rice.

The minutes of the March 9, 2015 meeting were approved and adopted on a motion by Alan Dambach, seconded by Dean Davis. ADAYE DDAYE

Casey Bowers, Senior VP and Joe Schwab, construction manager of Penn Energy spoke to the Supervisors updating them on the drilling in the Township. They are horizontally drilling the B-4, Depp Well, B-12, Steinbach Well will not be drilled in 2015. The B-17 Hoover Well, they are doing ground disturbance testing on it, B-9, Hamilton Well possible drill 2016-17. They will do core sampling of Township Roads that have wells located off of them before activity starts. Penn Energy bought the Heil property off of Route 588 near Herman Road to have a water impoundment area. The Township Officials will tour the Depp Well on May 4th at 6:00 p.m.

Lonnie Vodenichar of the Big Knob Fire Department advised the Board that the Department is selling the fire truck that was once under consideration of being located in our Township.

WATER: Jeremy Rice will have estimates to fix the broken line on the bridge for our next meeting. It was suggested to charge the line once it is fixed a couple of times a year as part of a maintenance plan.

The Supervisors received a letter of resignation from Tom Hartwig of Arcaidas as our engineer for our water system and the Veka sewage plant. The Supervisors will bring proposals to the next meeting for engineering for our water line and sewage plant if Tom Hartwig will not rescind his resignation. The water tower telemetry has been working properly. Jeremy Rice stated that the overflow pipe needs fixed.

SEWAGE: The Chapter 94 report was filed.

ROADS: The Road Tour report is as follows with costs on repair: Steinbach Rd – clean east side berm and 50' of pipe to drain - \$1500, Mueller Hill Rd – clean ditches - \$200, Ben Venue Rd - \$3400, Airport Dr – clean west side ditch - \$450, West Rd – OK, Veka Dr – patch holes bend, add stone to emergency access - \$1750, Herman Rd – patch holes, clean ditches lower end - \$1200, Petrie Rd – clean sod across from Barenfeld - \$90, Hart Rd – drain at Davis's – Lake Forest - \$3644, Township – 2556, Nagel Rd – patch holes, clean ditches - \$1150, Mecklem Rd – drain at upper end, pothole and ditch at Wenzel Daughter, clean berms, patch center of hill - \$4000, Householder Rd – patch holes – Gas Company?. Alan Dambach motioned to have Dirt Worx do the repairs listed in Road report, Dean Davis seconded. ADAYE DDAYE Alan Dambach motioned to approve and sign the Municipal Road Use Agreement with Cardinal Midstream, Dean Davis seconded. ADAYE DDAYE

POLICE: The Police Report for the month of March, 2015 was submitted and approved as follows: Total hours worked: 347 hours, Total mileage: 1953 miles, Total Calls: 20, Mutual aid calls: 11. The Crown Vic still does not have a radio.

PLANNING COMMISSION: The Planning Commission has finished work on the Flood Plain Ordinance and is waiting for clarification on one item.

ZONING: One building permit issued in the month of March to Lloyd Zahn for a house demolition. Marilyn Zona updated the Supervisors on her September 4, 2014 Zoning Report: Carver- demolition permit issued, Snyder and Kusserow- no repair or demolition, Kopp properties- no repair or demolition, Skillman, Monroe, Church – building permits obtained, Spencer – abandoned, Launer – demolition, Agnew, Simon, Weber – removal of vehicles and trash, Johnston- nothing done. The Supervisors gave no further direction to Mrs. Zona.

The Schaub property has been leased to Heather Wass.

Dean Davis motioned to approve the bid of Bob McDonough for \$20 mowing the Municipal building grass and \$45 for mowing the Schaub property, Alan Dambach seconded. ADAYE DDAYE

Alan Dambach motioned to approve the resignation of Carol Diehl as Township Auditor, Dean Davis seconded. ADAYE DDAYE

Dean Davis motioned to approve the Filing of Uncollected Taxes Report, Alan Dambach seconded. DDAYE ADAYE
The Supervisors approved Jeremy Rice to make the bathroom more Handicap accessible.

David Kopp told the Supervisors that a stream comes off of the Lehman property and runs onto Route 588 and in the winter it is a hazard because it creates ice on the road. He asked that the Township contact Penn Dot about the problem.

Alan Dambach motioned to pay the bills, Dean Davis seconded. Roll Call: Mr. Dambach-yes, Mr. Davis-yes
