WATER: The Faller meter still needs changed. It was decided to flush the hydrants the week of August 25th.

SEWAGE: After discussion the Supervisors decided there would be no money held in escrow for holding tanks for the gas well sites.

ROADS: The Secretary will get a price from Youngblood Paving for tar and chipping 150 feet at the north end of Herman Road. Mr. Rice reported that he still needs to do work on the berms of Ben Venue and Householder Roads. Dean Davis motioned to sign the contract with Central Salt through the COG, Alan Dambach seconded. PLANNING COMMISSION: The Commission reviewed a plan submitted by Dan Johnston that did not meet the requirements of the Subdivision Ordinance.

ZONING: Building permits issued in the month of July to Szulczewski-house, Veka- silo

SOLICITOR: Attorney Lope presented Ordinance 2014-1 repeal of Ordinance 08-04 withdrawal from the Butler County Sewage Association. Dean Davis motioned to adopt Ordinance 2014-1, Alan Dambach seconded. TGAYE ADAYE DDAYE

Mr. Dambach reported that the proposed lot for the Public Safety Building was forwarded to Honeywell.

The Secretary submitted a claim to EMC insurance for the Camera system that was damaged when the air conditioner flooded the office.

The Supervisors were presented with a letter signed by the Harts, Koppes, Alouises and Lisa Blanchette asking that the Township take action to have the property at 1174 Route 588 cleaned up for health and safety reasons. A letter will be sent to the property owner at 1174 and also the property at 1663 requesting action to clean up the properties.
