

The regular meeting of the Marion Township Supervisors was called to order on August 9, 2010, at 4:00 p.m., at the municipal building. Supervisors Thomas George, Alan Dambach, and Dean Davis were present. Also present were Rudy Harkins, Marilyn Zona, Philip Lope, William Hummel, Doug Rice, and Elnora Freshcorn.

The minutes of the July 12, 2010 meeting were approved and adopted on a motion by Dean Davis, seconded by Alan Dambach. TGAYE ADAYE DDAYE

WATER: Veka used a fire hydrant for about one and one half hours when they had a waterline break. Mr. George will check the readings of the main meter and come up with an average of how much they might have used. Rice Excavating will paint the fire hydrants. The Township will not flush the hydrants again this year.

ROADS: The Supervisors and Mr. Hummel met with Oliastro on Mecklem Road to discuss the project. Oliastro will put 3 drain boxes on Mecklem and bill the Township under a separate invoice. The Township will purchase the boxes. Mr. Hummel will inspect the project as it progresses. The Secretary will contact Larry Youngblood about a start date for the West Road project. Doug will patch the potholes on Veka Drive. Alan Dambach motioned to accept and sign the bid with A R Oliastro for cinders, Dean Davis seconded. TGAYE ADAYE DDAYE The Township received the report from Penn Dot on the traffic study for Hartzell School and Route 588. The speed limits will not be changed on either road. They will put intersection ahead signs for the intersection of Hartzell School and Pine Run Roads. Chief Harkins will continue to try and get no passing signs for that intersection.

POLICE: The Police Report for the month of July was submitted and approved as follows: Total hours worked: 364 hours, Total mileage: 2022 miles, Arrests-1, Citations issued: 12, Warnings issued: 16, Total Calls for July: 20, Mutual Aid calls: 1. The Chief and Officer Smith will attend training at the end of August.

PLANNING COMMISSION: The Commission is still working on the revisions to the Zoning Ordinance.

ZONING: Building permits issued in the month of July to Michael Wagner-deck, Michael Chrobak-pole building.
