

The regular meeting for the month of January of the Marion Township Supervisors was called to order on Monday January 11, 2016 at 4:00 p.m., at the municipal building. Supervisors Thomas George, Alan Dambach and Dean Davis were present. Also present were Philip Lope, Rudolph Harkins, Marilyn Zona, William Hummel, Elnora Freshcorn, Jeremy Rice, Doug Rice, Dave and Mary Kopp, and Lonnie Vodenichar.

The minutes of the December 14, 2015 were approved and adopted on a motion by Dean Davis, seconded by Alan Dambach. TGAYE ADAYE DDAYE

WATER: Mr. George reported that the JoAnne Martin readout is not working. Jeremy Rice to check it. The lid on the hydrant at West Road is missing. The Secretary is to make instructional cards for the water system.

SEWAGE: No report.

ROADS: Mr. Hummel reported a build-up of ice at the north end of Route 588 and Herman Road. Chief Harkins will check on it and report to Penn Dot. Jeremy Rice reported that the road signs, cross drain markers and culvert cleaning are done. The secretary is to check with Walsh Equipment about decals for signs.

POLICE: The Police Report for the month of December was submitted and approved as follows: Total Hours worked: 388 hours, Total mileage: 1630 miles, Total calls: 19, Mutual aid calls: 11. The Chief reported that he monitored the bus stop at Petrie Road and Chapel Drive. He spoke to the bus driver and the bus driver had no issues with the stop. He spoke with Mr. Trotta from the school and the bus company and they were unaware of any issues. The Supervisors instructed the Secretary to send a letter to the Hess's asking what bus stop they will use so that signs for bus stop ahead can be approved by Penn Dot and ordered. The Supervisors received a resignation letter from Patrolman Dakota Fennell effective January 25, 2016. Alan Dambach motioned to accept Dakota Fennell's resignation with regret, Dean Davis seconded. PLANNING COMMISSION: The Meehan Plan of Lots was presented for subdivision signature. Dean Davis motioned to approve and sign the Meehan Plan of Lots, Alan Dambach seconded. Attorney Lope reported that the hearing for the Court to grant permission for the Township to sell the Post Office Property is set for February 9, 2016 at 10:00 a.m. Once granted the closing on the property can take place.

Charles and Barbara Blinn have made application for a building permit and Conditional Use for an Event Destination for parties and weddings.

The Supervisors went into executive session at 5:10 p.m. to discuss the police merger, and returned to the regular meeting at 6:40 p.m.
