

The regular monthly meeting of the Marion Township Supervisors was called to order at 4:00 p.m. at the municipal building. Supervisors Thomas George, Alan Dambach and Dean Davis were present. Also present were Philip Lope, Rudolph Harkins, Marilyn Zona, William Hummel, Doug Rice, Elnora Freshcorn, Lonnie Vodenichar, Marcie Mowar, Diane Mitchell, Colleen Berg and Dave Kopp.

The minutes of the June 9, 2014 meeting were approved and adopted on a motion by Dean Davis, seconded by Alan Dambach. TGAYE ADAYE DDAYE

Lonnie Vodenichar from Big Knob Fire Department questioned the Supervisors about the progress on obtaining land and building a Public Safety Building. The Board will have Engineer Hummel draw up a plan of the land that the Township is trying to obtain from Honeywell. The Fire Department may sell the fire truck. He also told the Board that Penn Energy has received a permit from DEP to draw water from Brush Creek for fracking.

SEWAGE: Colleen Berg spoke to the Board asking them to consider withdrawing from the Butler County Sewage Association and hiring her as the Township's Primary SEO. Marcie Mowar and Diane Mitchell from Fergy Lake Apartments spoke for Mrs. Berg and giving her their support for the request. Alan Dambach motioned to hire Colleen Berg as the Township's Primary SEO and initiate the steps to withdraw from the Butler County Sewage Association, Dean Davis seconded. TGAYE ADAYE DDAYE Doug Rice advised the Board that Paul Kremer has requested Mr. Rice to obtain new grates for the Veka Sewage Plant.

WATER: The Faller and JB Booth meters still need changed. Mr. Rice told the Board that he had helped the Big Knob Fire Department place a Dry Fire Hydrant at Fergy's Lake. The pipe for it was expensive and Mr. Rice asked the Board if they would pay half the cost which would be \$200 and Mr. Rice would donate the other \$200. Alan Dambach motioned to pay \$200 for pipe used at Fergy's Lake for a Dry Fire Hydrant, Dean Davis seconded. TGAYE ADAYE DDAYE

ROADS: Youngblood was given the notice to proceed with the paving of Herman Road. The drain at Dindingers has been replaced with Gary Dindinger agreeing to pay for half of the pipe, the Township paying for the other half and for the patching of the road. The Secretary asked Mr. Rice to check the berms at the lower end of Householder Road.

POLICE: The Police Report for the month of June, 2014 was submitted and approved as follows: Total hours worked: 338 hours, Total mileage: 2158 miles, Traffic stops: 11, Total Calls: 21, Mutual Aid calls: 6. Chief Harkins advised the Board that he needs to purchase a metal lockable storage container for the assault rifle.

PLANNING COMMISSION: No report

ZONING: The Supervisors will have Building Inspector, Mark Reese, check the D'Zio property on Mueller Hill Road to ensure it is not a safety hazard.

Dean Davis motioned to have Bill Hummel survey the Mount Pleasant Cemetery to determine how much property is there, Alan Dambach seconded. TGAYE ADAYE DDAYE

The Secretary will call Zeigler Heating for a price on changing the zones in the municipal building.

Dean Davis motioned to transfer the gas well money received in 2012 and 2013 from the General Account to the Gas Well Account, Alan Dambach seconded. TGAYE ADAYE DDAYE

Dean Davis motioned to pay the bills, Alan Dambach seconded. Roll Call: Mr. George-yes, Mr. Dambach-yes, Mr. Davis- yes.

The Supervisors went into executive session at 5:40 p.m. to discuss the Police Chief's contract and returned at 6:08 p.m.
