

The regular meeting for the month of July, of the Marion Township Supervisors was called to order on Monday July 6, 2015, at 4:00 p.m., at the municipal building. Supervisors Thomas George, Alan Dambach were present with Dean Davis arriving 10 minutes late. Also present were Philip Lope, Rudolph Harkins, Marilyn Zona, William Hummel, Elnora Freshcorn and Casey Bowers.

The minutes of the June 8, 2015 meeting were approved and adopted on a motion by Alan Dambach, seconded by Thomas George. ADAYE TGAYE

WATER: There is no news on the repair of the line on the bridge. The quote from Kilmer Insurance to insurance our water lines is \$6537. The Supervisors decided not to insurance the water lines. Mr. George asked that Mike Wagner be advised again to clear the way to his water meter read out. The water tank inspection found no issues, the Township will inspect it again in 5 years.

ROADS: Summer Road Work: Ben Venue Road has not been done and is getting worse with all the rain. Mr. Dambach will check with Jeremy Rice to get a date for completion. The drains on Mecklem and Herman Road need cleaned. Mr. Hummel reported that North Sewickley has placed our portion of Glendale Road on their bid for paving. The Supervisors will wait to see what the bid for the paving is before they make a decision. Mr. Hummel reported that Oliastro suggested when oil bleeds through on the north end of Herman Road that the Township roll large stone into it instead of milling. The Supervisors will keep an eye on the road for bleeding.

SEWAGE: Alan Dambach motioned to proceed with enforcement if the Convery's have not installed their new septic system by August 1, 2015, Dean Davis seconded. TGAYE ADAYE DDAYE

ENGINEER: No report.

POLICE: The Police Report for the month of June was submitted and approved as follows: Total hours worked: 348.5 hours, Total mileage: 1686 miles, Total calls: 25, Mutual Aid: 12. The crown vic continues to have air conditioning problems. The Chief reported he had a presentation by Insync, a computer program to run the department in place of Visual Alert. Insync is \$595/ computer and Visual Alert is \$1056/computer. Chief Harkins is considering switching to Insync. Chief Harkins is also considering the purchase of a new computer.

PLANNING COMMISSION: The Commission is still working on the update of the Zoning Ordinance. Thomas Meehan granted and signed a 75 day extension for the Township's review of his sub-division. It extends the review until 9/25/15. The Township will have the SEO check the system of the house of Mr. Meehan's that is in our Township.

SOLICITOR: Attorney Lope presented the Municipal Road Use Agreement with Penn Energy for approval and signature. Alan Dambach motioned to approve and sign the Municipal Road Use Agreement with Penn Energy, crossing Mecklem and Householder Roads, Dean Davis seconded. TGAYE ADAYE DDAYE Attorney Lope advised the Board that he would be sending a seconded letter to the YMCA asking for payment in lieu of taxes.

Alan Dambach motioned to accept the quote from Electronic Recyclers International using the ERI White Glove Service to dispose of the televisions and computer equipment we collected from trash day, Dean Davis seconded. TGAYE ADAYE DDAYE

The Township received \$30,965.94 from the Act 13 Gas and Oil Impact Fees.

Dean Davis motioned to continue to lease the Post Office property as opposed to selling the property, Alan Dambach seconded. TGAYE ADAYE DDAYE
