

The regular monthly meeting was called to order at 4:00 p.m., Monday, June 11, 2012 at the municipal building. Supervisors Thomas George, Alan Dambach, Dean Davis were present. Also present were Philip Lope, Rudolph Harkins, Marilyn Zona, William Hummel, Doug Rice, Elnora Freshcorn, and David Hoover.

WATER: Mr. George reported the he had not heard back from Chad Garland concerning him becoming our Certified Water Operator. He will talk to Laura Blood about testing dates and will also contact Sam Alois and Tom Hartwig to see if they are interested. Mr. Rice reported that the waterline and hydrant for the West Road Agreement are done.

SEWAGE: The draft form of the NPDES Permit is being advertised for 30 days.

ROADS: The emergency road of the West Road Agreement needs one more load of gravel and the gate needs installed. There also has to be signs placed that read "Emergency Vehicles Only". Mr. Rice told the Board that his estimate for his part of the Summer Road Work is \$4830. Alan Dambach motioned to have Doug Rice complete the list of Summer Road Work at \$4830, Dean Davis seconded. POLICE: The Police Report for the month of May was submitted and approved as follows: Total hours worked: 203 hours, Total Mileage: 2226 miles, Traffic Citations: 3, Non Traffic Citations: 1, Arrests: 3, Total Calls: 17, Mutual Aid Calls: 7. Chief Harkins requested that the Supervisors establish a petty cash fund. The Supervisors discussed the work that would need to be done on the Post Office Property, a shower installed and electric for a kitchette for Stan Klimek to lease the property. Mr. Rice estimated for the Board that the shower would be \$3000. After much discussion it was decided to readvertise the property.
