

The regular meeting for the month of June of the Marion Township Supervisors was called to order on Monday, June 8, 2015, at 4:00 p.m., at the municipal building. Supervisors Thomas George and Dean Davis were present. Also present were Philip Lope, Rudolph Harkins, Marilyn Zona, William Hummel, Elnora Freshcorn, Jeremy Rice, Casey Bowers, Doug Rice, Dave & Mary Kopp, and Marie Latagliata.

The minutes of May 11, 2015 meeting were approved and adopted on a motion by Dean Davis, seconded by Thomas George. TGAYE DDAYE

Casey Bowers of Penn Energy attended the meeting to advise the Supervisors on the ongoing gas well activity in the Township. The B-4 Well (Depp) will be fracked, two wells in August and 2 wells in September. Pipe line construction has begun.

WATER: Jeremy Rice reported that they are waiting on the materials to repair the line across the bridge at Kennedy's. He has two different companies, Sunbelt and GM Rentals in line for the lift that will be needed. We received a letter from our insurance carrier denying the claim for the broken pipe across the bridge, the waterline is not insured. The water tank inspection will be June 10, 2015. The water tank will be inspected Wednesday, June 10, 2015.

SEWAGE: No report

ROADS: Jeremy Rice reported that he has completed the summer road work on Nagel, Mecklem, Petrie Roads and Veka Drive. Chief Harkins asked that the Township have the trees trimmed back on the hill on Mecklem Road. The Secretary will get quotes. The three quotes for the guide rails on Herman Road are as follows: Green Acres: \$5375, Penn Line: \$4093.75, Fence Maintenance by phone, written quote to be faxed: \$1730. Dean Davis motioned to accept the Fence Maintenance quote pending confirmation of the faxed quote, Tom George seconded. TGAYE DDAYE Oliastro sent a quote for the Municipal driveway of \$12,390.07 and to mill the north end of Herman Road \$680.00. The Supervisors tabled the work pending more quotes. Mr. Hummel told the Supervisors that North Sewickley would like to pave Glendale Road and would like Marion Township to agree to pay for the portion in our Township. The Supervisors will wait for the price.

POLICE: The Police Report for the month of May, 2015 was submitted and approved as follows: Total hours worked: 339 hours, Total mileage: 1837 miles, Total calls: 28, Mutual aid calls: 9. The Chief set July 2, 2015 at 7:30 for a Community Day meeting.

PLANNING COMMISSION: Dean Davis motioned to advertise the completed Flood Plain Ordinance, Tom George seconded. TGAYE DDAYE There are issues with septic for the Meehan Subdivision. The Supervisors will have our SEO inspect the houses that are in our Township that are part of the subdivision, but we have to confirm which houses are in our Township. Mr. Hummel will check with Shoup Engineering on the Township lines on the Subdivision.

ZONING: Building permits issued in the month of May to: Sharlow-house, Costa-in ground pool.

SOLICITOR: Attorney Lope reported that he received a letter from Attorney Hamilton about the August 1, 2015 deadline for Scott Convery to have his septic system completed. Attorney Lope will talk with the Township SEO about the steps that the Township must take if the septic is not in by the deadline. The question of the tax exempt status of the YMCA properties and no Payment in Lieu of Taxes was again discussed. The Township will again send a letter to the YMCA asking for such a Payment.

The tenant in the Post office property is leaving in September and the Supervisors need to decide whether they will lease again or sell. The Supervisors will have the property appraised.

Dean Davis motioned to have Thought Process Enterprises reconstruct our web site making it more mobile friendly and upgrading it for a price of \$1080, Tom George seconded. DDAYETGAYE
