

The regular meeting of the Marion Township Board of Supervisors was called to order on Monday, March 9, 2015, at 4:00 p.m., at the municipal building. Supervisors Thomas George and Dean Davis were present. Alan Dambach was absent. Also present were Philip Lope, Rudolph Harkins, Marilyn Zona, Linda George, William Hummel, Doug Rice, Elnora Freshcorn, David Hoover, Mike Chrobak and David Kopp.

The minutes of the February 9, 2015 meeting were approved and adopted on a motion by Dean Davis, seconded by Thomas George. TGAYE DDAYE

WATER: The Supervisors discussed the North Sewickley water line break and the subsequent discovery, when we tried to turn the water on from Zelianople to feed the Township, of the break in our water line on the bridge at J J Kennedy. Zelianople has agreed to pay half of the repair as per our agreement with them of November 12, 2007. Supervisor George will contact Tom Hartwig of Malcolm Pirnie, the engineers on the bridge project to discuss the break and to discuss an emergency response plan. The water tower telemetry has been operating without problems.

SEWAGE: Tom George motioned to approve and submit the Chrobak Planning Module to DEP, Dean Davis seconded. TGAYE DDAYE The Supervisors reviewed the correspondence from Tom Hartwig concerning the Chapter 94 reporting that now must be submitted to DEP. Mr. Hartwig will file the reports with the help of Paul Kremer and Marilyn Zona.

ROADS: The Supervisors reviewed the proposals for weed control from Coyner Enterprises for \$2950 and Stinson's proposal one for \$1920- 3 passes, and proposal two for \$1280- 2 passes. Dean Davis motioned to accept Stinson's Lawn Care Proposal Two provided they can mow two times, one in early summer and one in late summer, Tom George seconded. TGAYE DDAYE

POLICE: The Police Report for the month of February was submitted and approved as follows: Total hours worked: 330.5 hours, Total mileage: 1901 miles, Total Calls: 27, Mutual Aid calls: 11. The sale of the Tahoe is complete.

PLANNING COMMISSION: Mrs. Freshcorn presented the Chrobak Subdivision Lot Line Revision for approval. Dean Davis motioned to approve and sign the Chrobak Subdivision Lot Line Revision subject to Planning Module Approval, Thomas George seconded. TGAYE DDAYE The Planning Commission is working on the update to the Flood Plain Ordinance that must be adopted by August 17, 2015. Dean Davis motioned to authorize execution of the agreement with Cardinal Midstream for Road Maintenance Bonds on Householder and Mecklem Roads during the installation of a gas pipeline that will cross both roads, Thomas George seconded. TGAYE DDAYE

ZONING: A building permit was issued to David Barenfeld for an addition to his home and a demolition permit was issued to John Carver for the demolition of structures at 586 Glendale Road. Marilyn Zona discussed the structures at 1174 and 1192 Route 588 owned by David and Mary Kopp that are in dilapidated condition and no work has begun to clean up the structures.

SOLICITOR: No report.

The Township property at 487 Hartzell School Road is still being renovated.

The plan for Penn Energy to withdraw water from the Connoquenessing Creek and have storage on the former Heil property was discussed, with concerns raised by Chief Harkins about traffic in and out of the property on Route 588. The question of how the temporary above ground water line that is planned to go from Brush Creek to the Depp well will cross the roads in our Township. Chief Harkins will ask Penn Energy to attend our next meeting.

Davey Tree Service has left brush in the creek that flows beside Honeywell on Route 588. The Secretary will contact Penn Power in the hopes of having someone clean it up.

Dean Davis motioned to pay the bills, Tom George seconded. Roll Call: Mr. George-yes, Mr. Davis-yes

Dean Davis motioned to approve and sign the State Municipal Pensions and Fire Relief form, Tom George seconded. DDAYE TGAYE

Dean Davis motioned to set May 9, 2015 for cleanup day for the Township, Tom George seconded. DDAYE TGAYE

Dean Davis set April 9, 2015 at 9:00 a.m. for Road Inspection beginning at the municipal building, Tom George seconded. DDAYE TGAYE
