WATER: Frank Sidari reported that Gannett Fleming has contacted PA American Water concerning supplying water to the Airport. Gannett Fleming told Frank that the ultimate usage for the Airport Industrial Park is 8400 gallons/day. Mr. Sidari will compose a letter to Gannett Fleming stating the Townships position on supplying water to the Industrial Park. Alan Dambach motioned to adopted the Amendment to Ordinance 87-2 concerning residential pressure pumps, Dean Davis seconded. SEWAGE: Dean Davis motioned to approve and sign the Monthly Sewage Report, Alan Dambach seconded. TGAYE DDAYE ADAYE

ROADS: Veka is complaining about the condition of Veka Drive and asking who is responsible for the condition of the railroad crossing. The problems on Veka Drive stem from the semi truck traffic. The long term solution on the bend is to pave to the grate when Veka Drive is paved. Doug Rice will put stone there for now and patch the potholes. Doug Rice will also clean the ditch on the east side of Steinbach Road by Kaisers, patch the potholes on Mueller Hill Road, clean the berms on the paved end of Ben Venue, fix the dirt end of Ben Venue where the bank is eroding, check Mecklem where the berms have washed out, and put arrow signs on the bend on Herman road.

SOLICITOR: Attorney Lope presented the Board with a proposed Rental Ordinance. The Board will review it for the next meeting. Attorney Lope told the Board that Bettors is ready to sign over the Post Office property.
