

The regular meeting for the month of November of the Marion Township Supervisors was called to order on Monday, November 14, 2016, at 4:00 p.m., at the municipal building. Supervisors Thomas George, Alan Dambach, and Dean Davis were present. Also present were Philip Lope, Frank Evanson, Marilyn Zona, William Hummel, Elnora Freshcorn, David Kopp and Casey Bowers.

The minutes of the October 4, 10, November 3 and 7, 2016 meetings were approved and adopted on a motion by Alan Dambach, seconded by Dean Davis. TGAYE ADAYE DDAYE

WATER: No report

SEWAGE: No report

ROADS: Alan Dambach motioned to approved replacement of the catch basin on the north end of Householder Road, Dean Davis seconded. The Supervisors will check on the dead ash tree on Ben Venue to determine if it needs to come down.

POLICE: The Police Report for the month of October was submitted and approved as follows: Total hours worked: 335.5 hours, Total Calls: 33. The Police continue to monitor bus stops and are running traffic on all roads. Dean Davis motioned to have the odometer on the Expedition repaired, Alan Dambach seconded. PLANNING COMMISSION: Mrs. Freshcorn reported that the Planning Commission had a busy meeting.

ZONING: There were no building permits issued in the month of October.

SOLICITOR: Attorney Lope reported that the Convery septic issue is close to being resolved. He also reported that the Blinn's must file an Appeal of the Uniform Construction Code in order to move forward with obtaining a building permit and final approval of their Conditional Use Permit. The Mutual Aid Agreements have not yet been returned.

The proposed Budgets for 2017 were presented with no tax increase: General Fund - Total Available - \$487,250, Total Expenditures - \$ 351,200, State Fund – Total Available – 47,442, Total Expenditures - \$47,442, Sewage Fund – Total Available - \$63,025, Total Expenditures - \$47,725, Water Fund – Total Available – 610,100, Total Expenditures – 259,435.

Alan Dambach motioned to advertise the Proposed Marion Township 2017 Budget for adoption December 12, 2016, Dean Davis seconded. TGAYE ADAYE DDAYE
