

The Budget Meeting of November 4, 2010 was called to order at 7:00 p.m. at the municipal building. Supervisors Thomas George, Alan Dambach, and Dean Davis were present. Also present were Marilyn Zona and Rudolph Harkins.

The Supervisors completed the General Fund Budget with Total Available of \$406,970 and Total Expenditures of \$302,475. The Supervisors will have the first reading of the Budget at the meeting on November 8, 2010.

The regular meeting of the Marion Township Supervisors was called to order at 4:00 p.m., Monday, November 8, 2010, at the municipal building. Supervisors Thomas George, Alan Dambach, and Dean Davis were present. Also present were Marilyn Zona, Philip Lope, Rudolph Harkins, Elnora Freshcorn, William Hummel, Doug Rice, and David Hoover.

The minutes of the October 11, 19, 21, 2010 meetings were approved and adopted on a motion by Dean Davis, seconded by Alan Dambach. TGAYE ADAYE DDAYE

WATER: Mr. George reported that the Caldwell readout was not working. Alan Dambach motioned to raise the price of water from \$6.50/1,000 gallons to \$7.00/1,000 gallons beginning with water used in January, 2011, and advertise the amendment to the Water Ordinance, Dean Davis seconded. SEWAGE: Alan Dambach motioned to approve and sign the Monthly Sewage Report, Dean Davis seconded. TGAYE ADAYE DDAYE

ROADS: The Supervisors will have Attorney Lope talk to Larry Youngblood and tell him that the paving of West Road must be done this week (the week of November 7, 2010) or wait until the spring and honor the price of the contract.

POLICE: The Police Report for October, 2010 was submitted and approved as follows: Total Hours worked: 340.5 hours, Total Mileage: 1,868 miles, Arrests: 2, Citations issued: 19 Warnings issued: 16, Total Calls: 13, Mutual Aid Calls: 3. The Chief will ask for a new patrol vehicle for the 2012 Budget instead of this year because the Ford SUV pursuit certified vehicle will not be available until then.

PLANNING COMMISSION: The Commission is working on Zoning revisions.

ZONING: Permits issued in the month of October: Sign Permit- Camp Kon-O-Kwee, Building Permit- Kraus Farm.

Supervisor Davis reported on the Emergency Management Meeting he attended. The Federal Government is narrowing the width of the ban for radio frequencies by 2013 and our radios will be retuned by the County at no cost. The Township must have an office for Emergency Management equipped with a computer, phone and maps. The Township needs to review their house numbering to make sure that every home including camps are numbered and that property with buildings on it without homes must also be numbered. All Officials of the Township must be NIMS certified.

The Secretary read the First Reading of the Budgets with Total Available in all Budgets of \$885,313 and Total Expenditures of \$568,043. Alan Dambach motioned to advertise the Budget for adoption at the December 13, 2010 meeting, Dean Davis seconded. TGAYE ADAYE DDAYE
