

The regular meeting for the month of October of the Marion Township Supervisors was called to order on Monday, October 10, 2016, at 4:00 p.m., at the municipal building. Supervisors Thomas George, Alan Dambach and Dean Davis were present. Also present were Philip Lope, William Hummel, Marilyn Zona, Elnora Freshcorn, Jeremy Rice and Dave Kopp.

The minutes of the September 12, 2016 meeting were approved and adopted on a motion by Dean Davis, seconded by Alan Dambach. TGAYE ADAYE DDAYE

WATER: Alan Dambach motioned to adopt Resolution 2016-3, request for a PA Small Water and Sewer Program grant of \$403,750 from the Commonwealth Financing Authority to build a waterline on Herman Road, Dean Davis seconded. TGAYE ADAYE DDAYE

SEWAGE: Tom Thompson of Gannett Fleming is working on the Marion Township NPDES permit for the Veka Sewage Plant.

ROADS: There was only one bid for snow removal, Jenny LTD for \$78.00/hour. Alan Dambach motioned to accept the bid from Jenny LTD for snow removal for Marion Township, Dean Davis seconded. TGAYE ADAYE DDAYE All the paving in the Township is complete and the berms have been filled. The summer road projects are also complete.

POLICE: The Police Report for the month of September was submitted and approved as follows: Total hours worked: 297.5 hours, Total calls: 17. The police are working on a dumping problem off Ben Venue Road.

PLANNING COMMISSION: No report.

ZONING: No building permits were issued in the month of September. Pam Osborne sent a letter to the Township detailing the cleanup of her property.

SOLICITOR: Attorney Lope explained to the Board his semiretirement and cut back in hours. Attorney Chris Reese will assume the major workload of the Township. The Supervisors told Attorney Lope that Scott Convery needs to move forward with his septic system before the weather will not permit it. Mr. Lope will contact the Convery attorney. The Supervisors will give the Blinn Event Center one week to comply with the conditions set forth in the Conditional Use Permit. Attorney Lope will contact their engineer, Jackie Mazza. The revised Mutual Aid Agreements have been sent to bordering municipalities.

Alan Dambach motioned to approve and sign the contract with John Sockaci Building and Remodeling to remodel the Township Office and meeting room for \$12,250, Dean Davis seconded. TGAYE ADAYE DDAYE

The budget meeting that was scheduled for October 6<sup>th</sup> was rescheduled for November 3, 2016 and there is also a meeting November 7<sup>th</sup> as previously advertised.
