

The regular monthly meeting of the Marion Township Supervisors was called to order at 4:00 p.m., Monday, October 11, 2010 at the municipal building. Supervisors Alan Dambach, and Dean Davis were present. Thomas George was absent. Also present were Philip Lope, Rudy Harkins, Marilyn Zona, William Hummel, Elnora Freshcorn, Doug Rice, Jake Dietrich, Sue Dietrich, and Michael Dietrich.

The minutes of the September 13, 2010 meeting were approved and adopted on a motion by Alan Dambach, seconded by Dean Davis. ADAYE DDAYE

Michael Dietrich spoke to the Supervisors about the condition of Herman Road. He told them it is not speed that is the problem, that at a certain spot on the road you are shot across the road. He said he had called many times in the past three years but that while the bridge was closed at Brush Creek Park there were not any problems because there was no traffic on the road. The ridges that the Township put in the road have worn off. Supervisor Dambach and Chief Harkins will meet with Mr. Dietrich Tuesday, October 12, at 8:30 a.m. at the site.

WATER: The insurance paid \$949.50 for the damage to the telemetry that happened in June. The flushing and painting of the fire hydrants is done.

SEWAGE: Alan Dambach motioned to approve and sign the Monthly Sewage Report, Dean Davis seconded. ADAYE DDAYE

ROADS: Mr. Hummel reported that Youngblood will pave West Road in the next one to two weeks. Mr. Hummel reported that Camp Kon-O-Kwee contacted him about widening their road, needing to know where Nagel Road ends. The Camp is replacing there sign at the entrance and building a tree house. They will be contacted concerning a sign permit and building permit. There was only one bid received for snow removal. The Jenny LTD bid was opened and the bid was \$72.00/hour. Alan Dambach motioned to accept the Jenny LTD bid for snow removal, Dean Davis seconded. ADAYE DDAYE The Chief reported that the asphalt outside the big garage door has been damaged by the large trucks from Swank getting water. They will be contacted.

POLICE: The Police Report for the month of September was submitted and approved as follows: Total hours worked: 360.5 hours, Total mileage: 1886 miles, Arrests: 1, Traffic citations issued: 19, Traffic warnings issued: 16, Total Calls for September 2010: 13, Mutual Aid Calls: 4. The Chief has started a fund drive for the purchase of a new AED.

SOLICITOR: Attorney Lope reported that he sent a letter to the railroad concerning the problem that emergency vehicles cannot cross the bridge. He also reported to the Supervisors about the answers received from the Butler County Sewage Association about the By-Laws.
