

The regular meeting for the month of April of the Marion Township Supervisors was called to order on Monday, April 11, 2022, at 4:00 p.m., at the municipal building. Supervisors Dean Davis, Thomas George and Alan Dambach were present. Also present were Chris Reese, Mike Pszenny, Marilyn Zona, Tom Thompson, Jeremy Rice, Roy Raida, Don King, Mr. & Mrs. Griffen, and Amanda Peterson,

Dean Davis motioned to approve and adopt the minutes of the March 14, 2022 meeting, Alan Dambach seconded. TGAYE DDAYE ADAYE

WATER: Honeywell's meter has been installed, J J Kennedy and YMCA by the end of the week. The report on the water tower inspection will be reviewed by Supervisors and Engineer to see if any work needs to be done. It was reported that Senator Vogel and Representative Marshall have sent letters of recommendation for Marion Township for the Statewide Local Share Assessment grant of \$691,800 from the Commonwealth Financing Authority for the Herman Road Waterline Project. Zelenople has increased the rate Marion Township will pay for water if needed to \$7.09/1000 gallons.

SEWAGE: The Solicitor presented the letter for approval, to be sent to Veka, advising them that they are in noncompliance of the Sewer Users Agreement that the Township has with Veka. They are not submitting quarterly discharge monitoring reports to the Township. The Township will advise Veka that the 30+ year old plant has maintenance issues that need to be addressed. Since Veka is the only user, they will be responsible for the cost.

ROADS: Dean Davis motioned that the signs for the Herman Road bend will be ordered and installed on the recommendation of the engineer by the next meeting, Alan Dambach seconded. Steinbach Road has been patched. Road Inspection is set for April 19 at 9:00 a.m.

ENGINEER: No report.

POLICE: The Police Report for the month of March, 2022 was submitted and approved as follows: Total hours worked: 359.5 hours, Total Calls: 38, Mutual aid: 4, New Sewickley: 14 calls. The Mutual Aid Agreement with Franklin Township has been signed. The new speed sign is in production. The County radio system purchases were discussed. The County is paying for 80% of the cost of new Motorola radios to 5G, the Township will be responsible for the remaining 20%. The Township currently uses Kenwood radios which are considerably cheaper than the Motorola's. Alan Dambach motioned to donate \$50 to the Beaver County Police Memorial Fund, Dean Davis seconded. PLANNING COMMISSION: Dean Davis motioned to accept the Caldwell request for extension of time for review of their subdivision plan until July 1, 2022. Alan Dambach seconded.
