

The regular meeting for the month of April of the Marion Township Supervisors was called to order on Monday, April 13, 2020, at 4:00 p.m., on a Zoom Internet conference. Supervisors Thomas George, Dean Davis and Alan Dambach were all present via Zoom teleconference. Also present on Zoom were Chris Reese, Michael Pszenny and Marilyn Zona.

Dean Davis motioned to approve and adopt the minutes of March 9, 2020 meeting, Alan Dambach seconded. TGAYE DDAYE ADAYE

WATER: There was a leak at the base of the water tank, discovered by Jeremy Rice. Mid Atlantic came and repaired the leak. Jeremy Rice has checked most of the main lines in the Township and has not discovered any leaks. The line below Honeywell needs to be flushed and checked more closely. Hopefully there is a blowoff valve at the end of the line below Honeywell, if not the Township will have one put in. The Supervisors again discussed which ten meters would get the remote reading from the Beacon Kit we are purchasing. The Secretary will check with the salesman concerning questions about location and if the size of the meter matters.

SEWAGE: No report

ROADS: Stinson's will be mowing the roads sometime the end of June. Bill Hummel reported to the Secretary that there are potholes on Herman Road that need attention. He also reported that he checked Herman Road for damage from the pipeline construction. There are some areas where the edges of the road are breaking up. The Township will talk to Penn Energy about this. Road Inspection will be rescheduled as soon as it is permissible due to the Covid 19 Virus.

ENGINEER: No report.

POLICE: The Police Report for the month of March, 2020 was submitted and approved as follows: Total hours worked: 347 hours, Total Calls: 44, Mutual aid: 1, New Sewickley: 12calls. The Department moved the solar speed limit sign to Herman Road. The Supervisors discussed with Chief Pszenny the pattern of traffic on Herman Road with just a few days of statistics. Alan Dambach motioned to extend the Contract with New Sewickley until the end of 2020 at the same rate of \$2,083.33/month, Dean Davis seconded. TGAYE ADAYE DDAYE The department received a box of N95 face masks from the County and has purchased hand sanitizer.

PLANNING COMMISSION: No report

ZONING: Building permits issued in the month of March – none.

SOLICITOR: Attorney Reese spoke with Susan Buckman concerning the Blinn Venue. The Bill concerning building laws for Historic Barns is still being actively considered but there is no movement. Trash day is still being considered for May 16, 2020.

The Supervisor are still considering having Community Day on August 15, 2020.
