

The regular meeting for the month of April of the Marion Township Supervisors was called to order on Monday, April 9, 2018, at 4:00 p.m., at the municipal building. Supervisors Thomas George and Dean Davis were present with Supervisor Alan Dambach attending via phone. Also present were Chris Reese, Marilyn Zona, William Hummel, Doug Rice, Chad Garland, Dani Fitzgerald and Dave Kopp.

Dean Davis motioned to approve and adopt the minutes of the March 12, 2018 meeting, Tom George seconded. TGAYE DDAYE ADAYE

WATER: Chad Garland presented a new Interconnect Agreement with Zelianople. Dean Davis motioned to approve and sign the Interconnect Agreement with Zelianople, Tom George seconded. DDAYE TFAYE ADAYE Attorney Reese explained proceedings when a water customer files for bankruptcy owing the Township for water. The Township may place a lien on the property for the amount owed at the time the bankruptcy was filed. If the water used after the bankruptcy was filed goes unpaid, the Township may shut off the water.
