

The regular meeting for the month of August of the Marion Township Supervisors was called to order on Monday, August 10, 2020, at 4:00 p.m., at the municipal building. Supervisors Dean Davis, Alan Dambach and Thomas George were present. Also present were Chris Reese, Michael Pszenny, William Hummel, Marilyn Zona, Gary Sheets, Dave Kopp and Barb Blinn.

Dean Davis motioned to approve and adopt the minutes of July 13, 2020 meeting, Tom George seconded. TGAYE DDAYE

Gary Sheets from Larsen Design Group spoke to the Supervisors about the quote that Larsen Design Group submitted to use GIS to map the Township water system. The Township will approve the agreement to join with the Beaver County Council of Governments shared Municipal GIS program for \$2,900. The contract with Larsen Design for the water system is \$7,500. Dean Davis motioned to adopt and sign Resolution 2020-3 The Shared Municipal GIS program with the Beaver County Council of Governments, Alan Dambach seconded. WATER: The remote readout at the Honeywell building at the school still needs replaced. The Supervisors discussed the quotes from National Road Supply with Ken McLaughlin by phone. Ken explained all of the components in the quotes. Alan Dambach motioned to purchase 3 meters to replace the Barenfeld meter, Honeywell office meter and Honeywell school meter. 1 @ \$437.09 and 2 @ \$650.06, the purchase will also include the blowoff on the line behind Honeywell @ \$1,132.91, Dean Davis seconded. SEWAGE: No report
