

The regular meeting for the month of August of the Marion Township Supervisors was called to order on Monday August 14, 2017 at 4:00 p.m., at the municipal building. Supervisors Thomas George, Dean Davis and Alan Dambach were present. Also present were Chris Reese, Frank Evanson, Marilyn Zona, William Hummel, Wilbur Scott, Doug Rice, Dave Kopp, Roy Raida, Jeremy Rice, PJ Moldvan and Brian Perry.

The minutes of the July 10, 2017 meetings were approved and adopted on a motion by Dean Davis, seconded by Alan Dambach. TGAYE DDAYE ADAYE

WATER: The water tank has a small leak and Mid-Atlantic Storage Systems has been notified. The Rozzo water readout needs repair. Attorney Reese is working with Tom Thompson to amend the Water Agreements with Zelenople Borough and North Sewickley Authority to raise the Daily Water Withdrawal Limits.

SEWAGE: The NPDES Permit for the Veka Sewage Plant has been approved and issued. The Secretary will contact Tom Thompson on the Boron limit issue.

ROAD REPORT: The summer road work has been completed except for Herman Road. Lindy's quote for Nagel Road is \$14,000. Dean Davis motioned to have Lindy Paving pave Nagel Road for \$14,000, Tom George seconded. TGAYE DDAYE ADAYE

P J Moldvan and Brian Perry spoke to the Supervisors concerning the letter to be signed by Veka, Big Knob Fire Department, Harmony Fire District and the Beaver and Butler Emergency Services Centers. Big Knob will not sign the letter as it reads now. Attorney Reese will review the legality of Veka using the Harmony Fire District for their fire calls.

POLICE: The Police Report for the month of July was submitted and approved as follows: Total Hours worked: 321 hours, Total calls: 42, Traffic stops: 4, Arrests: 1, Mutual aid: 1. The Crown Vic has been sold on Muncibid for \$1975. Two kits (4 doses) of Narcan was received from the County for the Department and will be carried in the police vehicles. The Supervisors and Attorney Reese are continuing to review the draft to the Police Policy and Procedures Manual. Chief Evanson participated in the Touch a Truck event at Riverside.

PLANNING COMMISSION: Roy Raida presented the Board with a proposed Zoning Map. The Supervisors are reviewing the proposed Zoning Ordinance. The Planning Commission is revising the Junk Yard Ordinance.

ZONING: Building permits issued in the month of July to Ron Bender-new home, Mark Loaney-house addition.

Attorney Reese advised the Board that the Convery septic system is complete. The Supervisors instructed Attorney Reese to send a letter to the Blinns giving them until January 1, 2018 to receive a building permit and be complaint with MDIA and the terms of the Conditional Use Permit. If they do not comply the Township will not permit them to open for the 2018 event season.

The Supervisors thanked all those involved in making this year's Community Day a success.

The Supervisors are reviewing options for new chairs for the meeting room.
