

The regular meeting for the month of December of the Marion Township Supervisors was called to order on Monday, December 10, 2018, at 4:00 p.m., at the municipal building. Supervisors Thomas George, Dean Davis and Alan Dambach were present. Also present were Chris Reese, Marilyn Zona, William Hummel, Roy Raida Mike Pszeny, Mark Sentell, Brian Chlebus, Walter Clapton, Johnny Murtha and Brian Perry.

Dean Davis motioned to approve and adopt the minutes of the November 12, 2018 meeting, Alan Dambach seconded. TGAYE DDAYE ADAYE

Brian Chlebus, from Tetra Tech, representing Living Faith Baptist Church presented their site plans for new construction. Alan Dambach motioned to approve the plans subject to Engineer Hummel's review of the storm water portion of the site planning, Dean Davis seconded. TGAYE ADAYE DDAYE

Johnny Murtha presented the Big Knob Fire Department contract renewal to the Board. Dean Davis motioned to approve the Contract Extension until December 31, 2023 subject to Solicitor Reese's review, Alan Dambach seconded. TGAYE ADAYE DDAYE

Walter Clapton representing B C United, a community soccer organization explained the organization and asked the Supervisors if it is possible for the group to use the Township facility for a 5K race on Mothers Day weekend. When he has more information he will address the Supervisors again.

WATER: The floor in the North Sewickley meter pit has not been raised yet and the dehumidifier has not been installed. The list of spare parts has not been made yet. Roy Raida will take care of raising the floor in the meter pit. Supervisor George will contact an electrician to check the ground at the meter pit.

SEWAGE: The amendment to Ordinance 88-2 will be advertised for January 7, 2019

ROADS: The Supervisors will revisit the Herman Road project.

ENGINEER: No report

POLICE: The Police Report for the month of November, 2018 was submitted and approved as follows: Total hours worked: 293 hours, Total Calls: 21, Mutual aid: 0. New tires will be ordered for the Police Car. Alan Dambach motioned to hire Andrew Niederlander as a part time Patrolman at a rate of \$18.00/hour, Dean Davis seconded. TGAYE ADAYE DDAYE

PLANNING COMMISSION: The Commission presented the Junk/scrap/rubbish Ordinance to the Supervisors for review. The Planning Commission reviewed the Frank Rice application for Conditional Use and advised the Board that Mr. Rice should indeed file the application. The Richardson Conditional Use Applications was reviewed by the Planning Commission and it was decided that there is not a use, permitted or conditional in the Agricultural District that fits his use. The Secretary will send a letter to Mr. Richardson advising him of this but allowing that he has the right to a hearing if he wants one.

ZONING: Building permits issued in the month of November - none

SOLICITOR: Solicitor Reese's office uncovered 3 deeds for the Brush Creek Park. The deeds state that the Park must be used for recreation and the land was purchased with Act 70 money which also regulates use and care of the park. The Township will work with North Sewickley to formulate a plan to address the County Commissioners concerning the park.

There was no progress report from the Blinn's concerning the building permit for their party venue.

An Order of the Public Utility Commission was received relative to The West Road Bridge. Buffalo and Pittsburgh Railroad at its sole cost and expense has agreed to furnish material and perform all work to repair the bridge.

Alan Dambach motioned to adopt and sign Resolution 2019-7, The Marion Township 2019 Tax Rate, Dean Davis seconded. Roll Call: Mr. George-yes, Mr. Dambach- yes, Mr. Davis-yes.

Alan Dambach motioned to table Leslie Qualls petition to add her land to the Marion Township Agricultural Security Area, Dean Davis seconded. TGAYE ADAYE DDAYE

Dean Davis motioned to pay the bills, Alan Dambach seconded. Roll Call: Mr. George-yes, Mr. Davis-yes, Mr. Dambach -yes.
