

The regular meeting for the month of December of the Marion Township Supervisors was called to order on Monday, December 12, 2022, at 4:00 p.m., at the municipal building. Supervisors Thomas George, Alan Dambach and Dean Davis were present. Also present were Marilyn Zona, Mike Pzenny, Tom Thompson, Amanda Peterson, Jeremy Rice, Dave Kopp, Jay and Kathleen Griffen.

Dean Davis motioned to approve and adopt the minutes of the November 14, 2022 meeting, Alan Dambach seconded. TGAYE ADAYE DDAYE

WATER: The YMCA will make payments on the bill for the water not previously billed. The Township will attempt to place a meter pit at the curb stop for the Lukes household. Dean Davis motioned to adopt Resolution 2022-7 the rate increase for water sold in Marion Township, the rate is \$7.60/1000 gallons beginning with January water use, Alan Dambach seconded. ENGINEER: Tom Thompson reported that the Township has not received any word on the grant for Herman Road waterline.

POLICE: The Police Report for the month of November, 2022 was submitted and approved as follows: Total hours worked: 329 hours, Total Calls: 36, New Sewickley: 13 Mutual aid: 2. No parking signs need to be placed at the area on Route 588 where Penn Power has placed the barriers by the creek.

PLANNING COMMISSION: No report

ZONING: Building permits issued in the month of November- none. The house at 1174 Route 588 owned by Dave Kopp was burnt. The building at 1192 will be demolished in June, 2023.

SOLICITOR: There has been no movement on the House Bill concerning the Blinn Wedding Venue.
