

The regular meeting for the month of February of the Marion Township Supervisors was called to order on Monday, February 10, 2020, at 4:00 p.m., at the municipal building. Supervisors Thomas George and Dean Davis were present with Alan Dambach on the phone. Also present were Chris Reese, Marilyn Zona, Bill Hummel, Jeremy Rice, Barb Blinn and Roy Raida.

Dean Davis motioned to approve and adopt the minutes of December 9, 2019 and January 6 and 13, 2020 meetings, Alan Dambach seconded. TGAYE DDAYE ADAYE

WATER: Dean Davis motioned to accept and approve the new Drought Contingency Plan for the Marion Township Water System, Alan Dambach seconded. TGAYE DDAYE ADAYE Dean Davis motioned to approve the purchasing of the Starter Kit and online training for the Beacon advanced metering system at a price of \$2,900, Alan Dambach seconded.
