

The regular meeting for the month of February of the Marion Township Supervisors was called to order on Monday, February 11, 2019, at 4:00 p.m., at the municipal building. Supervisors Thomas George and Dean Davis were present, Supervisor Alan Dambach joined the meeting on the phone. Also present were Chris Reese, Marilyn Zona, Mike Pszenny, Roy Raida, Jeremy Rice, Amy Gonzalez, Bill Hummel and Dave Kopp.

Dean Davis motioned to approve and adopt the minutes of the 2019 Reorganization meeting and January 7 & 17, 2019 meeting, Tom George seconded. TGAYE DDAYE

WATER: The Supervisors again discussed the floor in the North Sewickley meter pit with Jeremy Rice and Roy Raida and changed the work to pouring concrete to raise the floor level to the drain because lowering the drain will not drain the center of the pit. The list of spare parts has been finished. Supervisor George will have the electrician install the surge protector and ground rod for the meter pit. The Secretary will clarify the new rate for water from North Sewickley Water Authority. The Township received a letter from the Authority about a rate increase but it only listed residential rates.

SEWAGE: Dean Davis motioned to approve and sign the Chapter 94 report for the Veka Sewage Treatment Plant, Tom George seconded. DDAYE TGAYE

ROADS: The Supervisors have changed the plan for the water problem on Herman Road and they must have a tree taken down. R & B Tree Service will remove the tree for \$1200. The Supervisors will contact them to also have the stump ground. The berm on the upper side of the road will be ditched and concrete gutter poured.

ENGINEER: Mr. Hummel is still working with the Baptist Church project concerning errors with the storm water.

POLICE: The Police Report for the month of January, 2019 was submitted and approved as follows: Total hours worked: 386 hours, Total Calls: 35, Mutual aid: 1.

PLANNING COMMISSION: Roy Raida presented the Hogan Plan for signatures.

ZONING: Building permits issued in the month of January - none

SOLICITOR: The Blinn's have hired Dan Franus to try and resolve issues with MDIA and obtain a building permit for their party venue. The Richardson's have decided to move the business materials from the property in the Township and will not apply for a Conditional Use. No movement on the Rice Conditional Use application. Attorney Reese is working with Attorney Ryan Long from North Sewickley Township concerning the condition of Brush Creek Park. The Townships will make a list of items of areas that need to be taken care of or have been neglected

The railroad has replaced the bearing block on the West Road Bridge. The secretary will contact the PUC concerning an inspection.

The Secretary will send a letter to Energy Transfer about cleaning up the area on Ben Venue where the company placed a pipeline for the Gas Well Industry.
