

The regular meeting for the month of February of the Marion Township Supervisors was called to order on Monday February 13 2017 at 4:00 p.m., at the municipal building. Supervisors Thomas George and Dean Davis were present, Supervisor Alan Dambach was absent. Also present were Chris Reese, Frank Evanson, Marilyn Zona, William Hummel, Jeremy Rice, Dave Kopp, Barb Blinn, Joanne Weil and Eric Poole.

The minutes of the January 3 & 9, 2017 meetings were approved and adopted on a motion by Dean Davis, seconded by Tom George. TGAYE DDAYE

WATER: The leak in the pressure reducing pit at Honeywell is fixed. There needs to be a new lock on the electric box at the meter pit in North Sewickley.

SEWAGE: Dean Davis motioned to approve and sign the Sewage Wasteload Report for the Veka Sewage plant, Tom George seconded. DDAYE TGAYE Dean Davis motioned to approve and sign the application for the Veka Sewage Plant NPDES renewal, Tom George seconded. DDAYE TGAYE

ROAD REPORT: No Report.

POLICE: The Police Report for the month of January was submitted and approved as follows: Total Hours worked: 352.5 hours, Total calls: 28. Chief Evanson and Asst Chief Pzenny attended an active shooter meeting at Riverside High School. The Department continues to monitor the bus routes. The estimate on a new Ford Explorer is \$35,851.85. The department would like to keep the Expedition and sell the Crown Vic. Chief Evanson advised the Supervisors that Fire calls for the Great Southern Wood Plant are given to Zelenople. The Chief will schedule a meeting with the Plant, Big Knob, Zelenople and the County to resolve the issues and put in writing how the calls will be handled.

PLANNING COMMISSION: The Planning Commission is continuing work on the updated Zoning Ordinance.

ZONING: No report.

Attorney Reese presented the Police Mutual Aid Agreement with North Sewickley. Dean Davis motioned to approved and sign the Mutual Aid Agreement with North Sewickley, Tom George seconded. TGAYE DDAYE

Barb Blinn discussed with the Supervisors the denial of her appeal to the Beaver County Regional Council of Governments UCC Board of Appeals. Attorney Reese will contact MDIA and let Mrs. Blinn know what steps she needs to take to have an approved building permit for the barn at her Event Center. A definition of A-2 and U-2 is also being sought.

Renovations are to start Thursday the 16th of February, the Secretary will have a temporary office in the Police Office.

The Supervisors have chosen May 20th or June 3rd as trash day dates. The Secretary will check with ECS&R to try and schedule an electronic recycling the same day.
