

The regular meeting for the month of January of the Marion Township Supervisors was called to order on Monday, January 7, 2019, at 4:30 p.m., at the municipal building. Supervisors Thomas George and Dean Davis were present, Supervisor Alan Dambach was absent. Also present were Chris Reese, Marilyn Zona, Frank Evanson, Roy Raida, Linda George, Jeremy Rice and Dave Kopp.

Dean Davis motioned to approve and adopt the minutes of the December 10, 2018 meeting, Tom George seconded. TGAYE DDAYE

WATER: The Supervisors discussed the floor in the North Sewickley meter pit with Jeremy Rice and decided to try and drill a drain hole at the base of the pit instead of pouring concrete to raise the floor. The list of spare parts has not been made yet. Supervisor George has contacted an electrician to check the ground at the meter pit.

SEWAGE: Dean Davis motioned to adopt and sign the amendment to Ordinance 88-2 raising the price/gallons of water used to \$6.00/ thousand and the base rate remaining the same for the Veka Sewage Treatment Plant, Tom George seconded. DDAYE TGAYE The Hogan Planning Module is in Harrisburg.

ROADS: The Supervisors will revisit the Herman Road project with a meeting with Bill Hummel at the site.

ENGINEER: Mr. Hummel has sent a letter to the engineer of the Baptist Church project concerning errors with the storm water.

POLICE: The Police Report for the month of December, 2018 was submitted and approved as follows: Total hours worked: 326.5 hours, Total Calls: 19, Mutual aid: 0. Chief Evanson reported that the department had 318 calls for 2018.

ZONING: Building permits issued in the month of December - none

SOLICITOR: There was no progress report from the Blinn's concerning the building permit for their party venue. No report on the progress of the repair of the West Road Bridge.

The tenant will be responsible for the lawn maintenance of the rental and the township property. The pet addendum and security deposit addendum will remain the same as the previous lease.
