

The regular meeting for the month of January of the Marion Township Supervisors was called to order on Monday, January 8, 2018, at 4:00 p.m., at the municipal building. Supervisors Thomas George and Dean Davis were present. Supervisor Alan Dambach joined the meeting via phone. Also present were Chris Reese, Mike Pszenny, Marilyn Zona, William Hummel, Casey Bowers, Jeremy Rice, and Roy Raida.

Dean Davis motioned to approve and adopt the minutes of the December 11, 2017 meeting, Tom George seconded. TGAYE DDAYE

WATER: Dean Davis motioned to approve and sign the yearly contract with Gannett Fleming for engineering services for the Water and Sewage departments, Tom George seconded. TGAYE DDAYE

SEWAGE: Dean Davis motioned to advertise Amendment to Ordinance 88-2, Sewage Ordinance, to raise the rate to \$4.00/1000 gallons of water plus a fixed charge of \$811.92, Tom George seconded. TGAYE DDAYE ADAYE

ROADS: The Penn Energy road improvement of Ben Venue Road still needs the cross drain at the gas well driveway completed. The utility needs to be moved so all work can be completed.

ENGINEER: No report

POLICE: The Police Report for the month of December, 2017 was submitted and approved as follows: Total hours worked: 272 hours, Total Calls: 21, Mutual aid: 1. Assistant Chief Pszenny reported that Marion Township is the only municipality in Beaver County with no reported opioid overdoses. The department has 2 sets of narcans in each police vehicle.

PLANNING COMMISSION: The Planning Commission will hold a hearing on the proposed Zoning Ordinance, January 29, 2018 at 7:30 p.m.

ZONING: Building permits issued in the month of December – Dennis Hamilton- storage building, Mark Loaney-deck, Ron Bender- occupancy permit home.

SOLICITOR: The Tax Collector has assured the Township that she will have her 2017 reports done soon. The Supervisors discussed the lack of a signed letter back from the Blinn's that they received September 16, 2017, detailing that they must have a building permit for the barn by March 31, 2018. If a permit is not obtained they will be in violation of the Building Code and Zoning Ordinance and not permitted to open the venue for 2018.

Dean Davis motioned to pay the bills, Tom George seconded. Roll Call: Mr. George-yes, Mr. Davis-yes Mr. Dambach-yes

Mr. Dambach ended his connection with the meeting.

The Supervisors went into executive session at 5:00 p.m. for personnel issues, and returned at 5:15 p.m.
