The Beaver County Sheriff's Office has informed our Police Department that they no longer patrol Brush Creek Park. The Township Police Department will patrol and answer calls in the Park. There has been a problem with parking along Veka Drive with kids parking there to get to the creek. The Chief asked for four more no parking signs and to have Jeremy Rice reconfigure the signs that are there. Chief Evanson and Assistant Chief Pzenny will join the Beaver County Chiefs of Police Association. As per the budget the Police department will purchase a paper shredder and computer.
